Detroit Beach Boat Club

Detroit Beach Boat Club was founded in 1939 by 32 men who all lived within the Detroit Beach Association subdivision. A single dock, which was home to a dozen boats, extended into Sandy Creek and the open waters of Lake Erie. A small garage-sized building was the gathering place. Early years saw little growth as the country was heavily focused on the war effort. Eventually, however, as fuel became more plentiful, fishermen gave way to families who enjoyed cruising on the lake and visiting neighboring clubs. Membership at the time was limited to Detroit Beach residents, so DBBC remained a quiet place where members enjoyed the "honor system" bar in the clubhouse and gathered under the large elm tree that grew on the dike.



1949 saw the club's first regatta in which hydroplanes raced out front on the lagoon waters. They were quite popular and became a part of the annual regatta

until 1961 when interest in these little boats diminished and the races were discontinued. To help fill the void, DBBC hosted a water ski exhibition but logistical problems associated with the huge crowds it attracted prompted the switch to the "Homecoming Steak Roast" format still used today. A Luau was added earlier in the summer as another entertainment option for members and the general public.

In 1965, membership expanded and an addition to the building on the east and west ends was completed, using mostly member volunteers. 1968 saw a unique construc-

tion project in which the center building was encased in a new two-story structure. The old section remained in use during this period of construction and was not torn down until the new shell was complete.

1970 saw the DBBC burgee and its members appearing at more and more distant events. It was not unusual to see visiting boats outnumbering home vessels at our docks on a summer weekend. Record high lake levels and high winds in April 1973 brought water surging over the dike wall to flood the club building and grounds. The membership pulled together and again made the necessary repairs. Improvements came yearly and it was not long before DBBC earned a reputation as a friendly port due to its social events and wonderful amenities. Declining interest and a changing neighborhood, along with the Vietnam War, took a toll on the membership in the early 70s. In 1975 membership was opened to non-subdivision property owners and the club began to fill with new faces. The new members helped make more improvements to the docks and clubhouse which in turn attracted even more members.

In 1984, the year after the Michigan DNR dredged Sandy Creek to maintain access to Sterling State Park, DBBC added a second-floor deck and bar facility followed by a large pavilion, playground, expanded parking lots and in 1989, a new dike. Improvements to existing structures and docks continued over the next twenty years, but the volunteers really got busy after 2010 when members approved the purchase of all the property, including the previously leased clubhouse land. The second-floor deck was renovated in 2015 along with replacement of the patio below it and in 2017, a complete renovation of the first-floor bar and hall area was completed. The top of the new bar which is three times bigger than the previous one was done in concrete with blue and white dye representing the lake we love. The future of DBBC is a bright one and our opportunities are limitless. There is no doubt why DBBC is "The Friendliest Club on Lake Erie.".

Tim spent the next 2 decades earning a degree in Criminal Justice, raising a family and working for the City of Sandusky Police Department. With his father an active businessman on the island, the island was always in the back of his mind. As the island became increasingly busy, he recognized that there was a shortage of modern hotel accommodations. When he retired from SCPD, he decided to address that shortage and built the Islander Inn. Two expansions and the acquisition of Parker's Inn, which was built where the old gas station used to be, gave him a facility large enough to house all of the Junior Bay sailors and their chaperones-which he has done now for over two decades. In 2007, he built the Niagara Event Center, which he allows I-LYA to use each year for banquets and awards at reduced rates. He is truly a great friend and supporter of I-LYA. Tim is also the force behind Bash at the Bay which has turned into a monster musical event at the end of each summer. Tim brings in civic groups, including the I-LYA, to help with this event and raise money for their respective organizations.

Historically Speaking

I-LYA 125 Years Ago (1895)



John E. Gunckel of Toledo's Ohio YC (soon merge after to with Toledo YC) was I-LYA's Commodore 1895. in Among the Commodore's other claims to fame were the formation of the Old Association Newsboys in Toledo (which later morphed into the Boys and Girls Club of Toledo), as a passenger agent for the Lake Shore and Michigan

Southern Railroad line, and telling comical fishing stories. Harry C. Kendall of Detroit's West End YC was Vice Commodore and J. J. Gill of Sandusky YC was Rear Commodore. This same year Detroit YC joined I-LYA, becoming the 10th club in the organization.

At the spring meeting, the trustees adopted the Seawanhaka Rule, requiring remeasurement and reclassification of every boat. The regatta, held the week of August 6th, at Put-in-Bay was a success but the complaints about the rules were loud and endless. The winners were *Clytie* of TYC in the special class, *Marie-M* of SYC in the 25 footers, *Undine* of PIBYC in the 30 footers, *Puritana* of TYC in the 40' class, *Sultana* of TYC in the 46' class and *Neva* of CYC in the 56 footers.

Sultana, owned by Commodore E.D. Potter Jr., was built under the old rules in 1894 to beat *Neva*, which she did without effort. *Puritana* was "the ship of the year for '95." She was built at Racine, WI, for Commodore S.O. Richardson Jr. It was the first year for *Priscilla* in fresh water, brought here by George H. Worthington of CYC after a remodel from her efforts as an America's Cup contender.

I-LYA 100 Years Ago (1920)


I-LYA's 1920 Commodore Frederick William Wakefield was a self-made man of his time. Born in Birmingham, England in 1863, he emigrated to the United States in 1875 and moved to Cleveland. He worked in a wire mill at 16 and soon after learned the art of metalworking. In 1887, he started working for C. A. Selzer & Co. Exporters dealing in light fixtures, brass goods, and bric-a-brac. He eventually left Selzer and started Gas Fixture and Brass Co. making light fixtures for Standard Lighting Fixtures of Cleveland. In 1905, at the age of 41 and as Commodore of Lakewood YC



(Lakewood would merge into Cleveland YC in 1908), he sailed his 28' cutter *Unique* into Vermilion harbor and told his companions it looked like a good place to locate a factory... and that is what he did. He sold his interest in his Cleveland firm and established F.W. Wakefield Brass Co. in Vermilion. The Wakefield Brass Co. invented battery-operated

running lights for small boats and an auto spotlight that could be changed instantly into a red danger light, among other lighting fixtures. He bought a summer house on the lake from Miss Cora Thompson in August of 1905. His home eventually became the Great Lakes Historical Society Museum (1953) and then the Inland Seas Maritime Museum which housed quite a bit of I-LYA history until it fell into disrepair and closed. In 1912, F.W. Wakefield was president of the Vermilion chamber of commerce and elected mayor (twice). He was a founding member of Vermilion YC. He and his family were featured, along with F.W.'s new 45' Matthews Tobermory, in Matthews Boat Co. advertisements which ran in the October 1914 Power Boating and Motorboating Magazines. Tobermory, built in Port Clinton, had one of the first diesel engines to be installed in a pleasure boat on the Great Lakes.





The 1920 I-LYA regatta was held (for the first and only time) in Erie, Pennsylvania over July 11-17. It was also the first dry regatta with prohibition finally kicking in with the ratification of the 18th Amendment and the Volsted Act. The regatta began with a long-distance powerboat race from Rocky River, Ohio to Erie, Pa. Held under International Power Boat Union rules, prizes totaling \$600 were divided among the first 10 boats finishing with a sterling trophy and flag to the winner. There was also a sailing distance race free-for-all from Rocky River to Erie with prizes totaling \$150 and a sterling trophy. Commodore Wakefield's Tobermory was the flagship and the Commodore's reception was held aboard Harry Parsons yacht, a 79' Matthews, Mahapa II. Along with the daily sail and powerboat racing, there were other sporting events-swimming, tennis, baseball, tug-of-war, rope climbing, running, a boxing exhibition and other field events. Novelty events included a night shirt race, mixed relay, wild goose chase, walking spar, canoe tilting, dingy and canoe races and water polo. No entry fee was charged for any event, but dinner and dance tickets were \$3 a plate, including the ball at Erie YC.

I-LYA 75 Years Ago (1945)

Commodore James A. Beidler Jr. of Toledo YC was in charge of I-LYA's 52 clubs in 1945. Commodore Beidler sailed frequently in the early 1900s and was Commodore of TYC in 1935. He owned five movie theaters in the Toledo area with his father James Sr. and bought a 1929, 39' Matthews which he eventually replaced with a cottage on Peach Point

at Put-in-Bay. He was PIBYC's commodore in 1956 and was active in both I-LYA and PIBYC for many years.

Serving with him were Lester R. Mylander of SYC as Vice Commodore, Edward W. Keifer of PHYC as Rear Commodore and I-LYA PC (1915) Harry C. Kendall of DYC as Secretary-Treasurer. Trustees were I-LYA PC Wilbur J. Wright of CYC, Arthur Summerlee of DYC and Lee Miller of PIBYC.

The Spring Meeting was held at the TYC and the meal was roast muskrat. The regatta dates were August 5–8 with 23 classes completing, the largest being the 8-Meters. The Lightnings were popular newcomers to I-LYA racing with the Stars, 30-Square Meters, Snipes, Interlakes, and K Cats also well represented.

Visiting clubs played for the softball championship. Buster Crabbe brought along his troupe of Olympic champions to put on a water carnival in front of the I-LYA headquarters at PIBYC. There was a "Gay Nineties" bicycle race for the Thundermug Trophy. The Ladies Cat Boat Races were on Monday the 6th with the first class at 3 P.M. on a 4.5 mile course. There was a bowling tournament at the Colonial Pavilion the next day. The Commodore's Reception was informal and held at the Park Hotel Tuesday evening.

For two of the three race days, 30 knot winds prevailed but the races were still sailed. During starting line maneuvers several yachts became tangled. The new Thistle class sailboat, designed, built and sailed by Sandy Douglass from VBC swept the Universal Class. Andie Carnegie of DYC won in the CK Class and George Harris of SYC swept the Star Class in *Ripple*.

I-LYA 50 Years Ago (1970)

Virl F. Berry of Forest City YC was Commodore of I-LYA with George L. Sackett of MHYC elected as Rear Commodore at 1969's fall meeting at Detroit's Hotel Whittier. Arthur N. O'Hara of VBC continued to Vice Commodore. The discussion at the spring and fall meetings at Hotel Pick-Carter in Cleveland were centered around Ohio's proposed anti-pollution laws.

I-LYA's Junior Championship was held Monday July 27th through Friday the 31st with Arnold Bahr of Lake County YC as chairman and Wm. "Scotty" Robertson of MHYC as vice. Entry fees were \$50 for each team with an additional \$28 per crew member to partially cover the cost of meals and housing. A team of four Juniors was preferred. However, the actual races were sailed by a skipper and two crew. The skipper, who was to be helmsman during the entire series, was designated at the time of registration. The alternate crew could be used in any of the races. Male crews and chaperones were housed at the Bayview Inn. The location of the evening meal was at the discretion of the chaperone. Junior girls were housed in quarters separate from the boys. No junior sailor was permitted to drive an automobile on the island during race week. The winning Thistle of the seven-race series was from Erie YC, manned by 14 year old skipper Doug Loesel and crew Clark Kuebler, Richard Esenberg, and Doug Russell.

The traditional regatta attracted 186 sail yachts in 25 classes. Threatening weather and the loss of a course boat created an upset attitude in some classes. Commodore Frank Miller's *Cat's Paw* won the K Class. Walt Swindeman Jr's *Red-S* from NCYC swept the cruising Class-B as did Lewis Wake's *White Elephant* from Detroit in the Thistles. John Mueller of CYC won the Lightning class on *Tickled Pink*, and *Cutty Shark*, skippered by Rick White of PIBYC, won the Shark Catamaran class. The only powerboat event was the Predicted Log for the Greeley Trophy, won by Frank Stallings of SYC. The fall meeting, traditionally a stag affair, changed to co-ed and the Yachtsman's Ball, previously held at Put-in-Bay during the regatta, became a part of it.

I-LYA 25 Years Ago (1995)

After participating in its activities for over 30 years, Clay Mock 1980 PC of MHYC took the helm of I-LYA. Clay began judging I-LYA races in the 1970s, was elected trustee in 1982, served on several committees, filled in for Commodore Snodgrass at the Junior Championships in 1986, and continued working that event for many years after. He was

the Chief Judge for the Junior Championships from 1990– 1997, advancing the level of race management, judging and training at the event. After his year leading I-LYA, Clay continued his stewardship of the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund for many years, ensuring the Fund's longevity.

The 40th I-LYA Junior Race Week began on Sunday, July 23^d with Chris and Lin Bartel from MHYC as Chairs and Arne and Marge Hanson from Jolly Roger SC as Vice Chairs. Filling up a busy Sunday was a racing clinic followed by the icebreaker dinner, meeting and group picture at Perry's Monument. Four days of racing saw 104 sailors representing 16 clubs. The winners in the Championship Series were Charles Vanderhorst, Christine Synowiec and Taylor Robinson of Hoover YC (Sears/Thistle), Michael Kaim and Stuart Lipp of MHYC (Bemis/JY-15), and Bill Bolas of CYC (Smythe/Laser). The juniors were housed at the Arlington House, Park Hotel, Perry Holiday and Pete's Retreat and the awards banquet was held at Tippers.

The weekend Deepwater feeder races brought sailboats to Put-in-Bay and the I-LYA Regatta sailing started on Monday July 31st with PC John Bureau of Perrysburg BC as PRO. The weekday racing continued through Wednesday. Top winners were: MORC Overall—*InfraRed*, Bryan Huntley, SSC and PHRF Overall—*Bullet*, Jim Samson, SSC. *Bullet* also won the I-LYA Blue Gavel Trophy for Lake Erie Boat of the Year for the 3^d consecutive year. This year also marked the 60th year of the Interlake class racing at I-LYA. The sailboats cleared the docks by 11:00 A.M. Thursday to make room for the Powerboat Regatta, arriving a half hour later.

The I-LYA Powerboat Regatta began August 3^d and ran through Sunday the 6th with 223 boats registered. The Chairman was Howard Jones of Bay View YC. Roger Viculis of Ford YC was the winner of both Predicted Log contests — the Greeley and I-LYA II — on *Lady Katherine* but the Commodore's Trophy went to John Thompson of Toledo YC on *Dawler*. In the softball game, the East beat the West 17 to 6 and Elba-Mar BC took home the Greatest Participation Award. The Junior Powerboat Navigation Contest was won by Kristine Kopsky (15) of WWYC.

1995 was also a year of sadness with the passing of 1964 I-LYA Commodore Frank H. Miller of BLYC/PIBYC, 1994 I-LYA Man of the Year Jim E. Crain of PIBYC, Dr. Dale Walker of VBC/SSC/MBIYC, Jack B. Springer of SSC/ SYC/CIC, and Joe LoPresti of PIBYC/MBIYC. On a happier note, Paul Pheiffer was awarded I-LYA Man of the Year for his many years of dedicated service to the organization.

I-LYA 10 Years Ago (2010)



The Commodore of I-LYA was John D. Stewart of West River Yacht and Cruising Club. John was drafted into the Army in May of 1967 and became the post's pre-eminent parachute packer—an art form for which hundreds of members of the 82^d Airborne are, to this day, very thankful. After the Army and several jobs, John decided he like being a

mixologist and a teller of tales. Practicing his trade at several Detroit area clubs led him to a job at Detroit Metro Airport and, in 1983, he became owner of the Double Eagle Lounge in Romulus Heights — "A bar with pool tables and he will take your money at both!" John married Nancy on December 31, 1985 and acquired two daughters by association. His first boat was a 34' cruiser named *Bull Ship*. He and Nancy joined WRYCC in 1997. He was elected to the WRYCC board in 1999 becoming Commodore in 2002. He served on the I-LYA Powerboat committee from 2003 to 2006 and in 2005 was elected to the I-LYA trustees. His Texas Hold'em tournaments at Michigan clubs were successful fund-raisers for his commodore year.

The flagship for the 2010 regatta was John's 41' Chris Craft Commander *Lovely Lady*. Commodores-in-waiting were Fred Schroeder from CCYC and Mike Morton from WYC. The 55th Junior regatta co-chairs were Matt & Sue Dubois and Patti & Todd Duffett from Grosse Ile YC. Junior Bay began on Sunday July 18th with registration, rigging, and inspection of boats at PIBYC. The juniors were housed at the Grand Islander Inn. The Icebreaker dinner, introductions and skits for the "Looney Toons" trophies took place at the Niagara Conference Center. The 155 participants, representing 17 different clubs and organizations, took their traditional group photos at the pirate ship between the Islander and Grand Islander hotels. First place winners from the three divisions were Charlie Yingling, Daniel Burns, and Harris Bransch from CYC (Sears/Thistle), Colin Mackay and AJ Rush from NCYC (Bemis/420), and John Fisher from ISC (Smythe/Laser). Long time volunteers Rob and Abby Ruhlman took home the "Thank You for Caring" Matt & Tracey Davis Family trophy.

The Powerboat regatta, chaired by John Bedford of SSCC, began on Wednesday July 28th and ended Sunday August 1st. The top awards went to Gary Coles of EMBC for both the Predicted Log (Greeley) and overall boat handling and weather contests (Commodore's Trophy). The Club Participation award went to WRYCC and the Club Volunteerism award went to SSCC.

The schedule for I-LYA's 117th Sail Regatta sailing changed from previous years. Following a slow decline of sailboat participation, Sail Chairman Bob Sheppard (ACSA/LLYC) was instrumental in moving the regatta from weekday to weekend racing, a change that had been successful at several other regattas around the country. The Deepwaters included races from Buffalo, Cleveland, Detroit, Port Clinton, and Toledo throughout the week and the Bay Week races were held Friday through Sunday. This was also the 75th anniversary of the Interlake class racing at I-LYA. Started at Sandusky Sailing Club, and originally called the SC² (Sandusky Sailing Club Class), the Interlake was designed by naval architect Francis Sweisguth of Rochester, NY for the waters of Sandusky Bay and Lake Erie and to be under 18 feet long. The reason for the length restriction was because SSC had recently raised their dockage rates from 25 cents/ft. to 60 cents/ft. for boats over 18 feet. Five SC2s raced in the 1935 I-LYA regatta. By 1936, the class was renamed to Interlake. Top trophy winners at the 2010 sail regatta were Matt Dubois of GIYC on Racer X—Blue Gavel/PHRF Boat of the Year & the Mike Smith Trophy/PHRF Class Overall, Jim & Chris Davis of NCYC on Orange Crate-Millennium Trophy/ JAM Class Overall, Patrick Green of PIBYC on Black Cat Racing—Parsons Trophy/Largest One-design Class/Hobie Wave, and Bob Bradley of JRSC on Red Hot-McDermott Memorial Trophy/Largest Small Centerboard Fleet.

The Yachtsmen of the Year award went to 2002 I-LYA Com. Douglas Hogan and Lady Pearl (Swan Boat Club). Notable losses this year were 1978 I-LYA Commodore Norm Winkel and 1997 Yachtsman of the Year John Dent.

Commodore Norm Winkel determined that recognition should be given to the many volunteers who freely donate their time, vacations, talents, expertise, and even boats and equipment to ensure the continued success of yacht racing competition and the I-LYA organization. 

Play Ball! A Short History of Bay Week Softball

Bay Week softball, as we now know it, began back in the early 70s when the I-LYA Sail Regatta hosted over 300 sailboats. The bigger sailboats had larger crews who spent a lot of time enjoying the party life of Put-in-Bay. Skippers felt their crews were not capable of performing at their best after an afternoon and evening of socializing. Thus, searching to find a good way for the young sailors to blow off steam following a day of racing, it was suggested that they play softball.

To the best of our knowledge, it was Commodore Keith Davis of Cooley Canal Yacht Club that enlisted some help from his home club and got Art Kreger and Bill Martin to organize a softball tournament using Mother of Sorrow's ball diamond. At that time, with the big boats and large crews, there were enough players to hold softball games over three days. Games were held on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday with accolades to the winners on Wednesday along with the racing awards. The winner of the first softball tournament in 1976 was NCYC. U.S. yacht clubs from Erie, PA. to Detroit, MI. as well as some Canadian clubs participated. Credit for establishing the tournament goes out to Art Kreger and Bill Martin from CCYC who were named the first I-LYA Sports Ashore Chairmen. Art and Bill were assisted by Dave Horn from EMBC.

By the late 80s, Mike Bureau had succeeded Art Kreger as Sports Ashore Chairman. As the size of the sail regatta diminished, the tournament grew smaller and ultimately moved over to the Powerboat Regatta. When Doug Hogan took over as Sports Ashore Chair in 1991, he tried a couple of things to build the softball tournament, but nothing seemed to work until he challenged Rocco DiLillo from West Channel YC to an East vs. West softball game. Doug Hogan was a Past Commodore of AYC (Associated Yacht Clubs) at the time, so a game against the members of GCBA (Greater Cleveland Boating Association) seemed like a great idea. Rocco accepted the challenge—loser buys a keg of beer—and the game was scheduled for Tuesday during the Powerboat Regatta. AYC won the first game and is still waiting for the keg! The Bureau Family contributed a trophy which was then given to the annual winner of the regatta softball game.

The softball game still continues today under new management. Dave Grey from CPYC took over as the chairman for GCBA for a period of time and was then replaced by Rich McKee Jr. who is still playing today. The Cousneau Family took over from Doug Hogan as the AYC Softball Chairman. Doug became the Softball Commissioner and home plate umpire with the three I-LYA Commodores as base umpires. Doug retired in 2018 after many years of great and happy memories.


2007 Commodore James D. DuPré *June 25, 1941 – July 17, 2019*

He loved fishing, hunting and most of all boating. He and Betty joined River View Yacht Club in 1980. The membership was a birthday present to Betty, but as Jim's love of boating had began long before that, it didn't take long before they were both very involved in the club. In the mid 80s Jim and Betty decided they would like to take part in I-LYA and never missed a year after that. Jim held several offices at RVYC and in 1996 decided it was time to be the Commodore. While holding that office he told his Bridge Officers that he expected them to be at the I-LYA regatta that summer, as none of them had ever attended, and they honored his wish. One of those officers has never missed a year since. That officer being RVYC PC Al Antoine.

In 2002 while serving as one of Commodore Doug Hogan's Fleet Captains, Jim thought he would like to be even more involved in I-LYA and decided to run for the office of trustee. He was elected to the position and that same year he became the Commodore of River View for the second time. It was while serving as I-LYA trustee that he decided it was time for him to seek the postion of I-LYA Commodore. "Never a dull moment with this man," was Betty's saying. So in 2007, Jim became the Commodore of I-LYA. While going through the chairs of I-LYA, he and ORYC PC Gary Ryan started the Junior Power program and, thanks to this year's Rear Commodore Bob Lang, it is doing very well today.

The 96th Commodore of the Inter-Lake Yachting Association hailed From Edgewater Yacht Club in Cleveland. An avid sailor who loved to be involved in all aspects of the sport, he was particularly proud of his time dedicated to I-LYA.

Rolf and Marilyn joined Edgewater in 1969 and soon became immersed in every aspect of the club and all that it had to offer. Racing their Flying Scot, *Witch Thimble*, they traveled near and far. Their travels included such far off destinations as Deep Creek, Maryland for the Nationals—it was all their Ford Fairlane 500 could muster through the eastern hills of the US!



Back in Ohio, the trip of the summer was always to Put-in-Bay. Over the years, their friends on the island read like a who's who. Their children, Stephanie, Dave, Tom, and Andy always had a "parent" watching over them no matter where they went. From the first days staying at the State Park to the present day, they have always felt the welcome only Islanders could give.

Rolf encouraged the Association to greater involvement in one design racing. In the years leading up to the 1976 Olympics, I-LYA held "Spirit" regattas at Sandusky attracting sailing greats such as the Harken Brothers and Olympic great Peter Barrett to Lake Erie. One of the sto-

ries goes that Bill Bentsen of the US Olympic Committee was there to observe the racing. Noticing a power boat with a bunch of "guys in whites," he inquired who they were. After hearing they were all Past Commodores, his response was, "Do you mean to say you let Commodores run your race committee? At our club we don't even let them on the race course!"

Organizing events and individuals the likes of John and Phoebe Borman, Jim Crane, and cadre of Commodores, Rolf immersed himself in volunteering his time to ensure that the regattas were as successful as possible. Later, he would also serve as the President of the Yacht Racing Union of the Great Lakes and organized several runnings of the Great Lakes Championship, a match racing event. Many other organizations also benefitted from his time. He served as Commodore of the Ohio Inter-Club Yachting Association, Rear



Commodore of MORC International, Vice Commodore of MORC Station 14, and as a United States Yacht Racing Union Certified Race Officer.

Rolf and Marilyn gave every ounce of their time to the Inter-Lake Yachting Association. As memorialized on cocktail napkins from his 1989 Commodore year stated, "Yachting forever—yardwork whenever!"

Daniel van Heeckeren

Commodore Daniel W. van Heeckeren served I-LYA as Commodore in 2003. Born in Nootdorp, Netherlands in 1936, descendant of a Dutch royal family, Dan held the title of Baron. After immigrating to the United States and becoming a U.S. citizen in 1970, he was no longer eligible to use that title. "Dr. Dan" attended Colby College in Waterville, Maine where he received his BA in physics, Harvard Medical School, where he earned his MD, Yale-New Haven Hospital where he was a Resident and then Chief Resident of Surgery, and Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, Sweden as a Fellow in cardiothoracic surgery. Working in a number of Cleveland area hospitals throughout his career, and as an Assistant Professor at Case Western Reserve University, he saved thousands of lives and taught hundreds of medical students surgical procedures and bedside manner, thus saving many thousands more throughout his career. He and his wife, Doris, were well known for their philanthropy—championing democracy, justice, and equal

rights for all, educating young people in sailing & boating, and helping others living with Parkinson's disease, among many others. As members of Mentor Harbor Yachting Club, and later Edgewater Yacht Club, Dan & Doris were very active in sailing on Lake Erie, in I-LYA, and in US Sailing as a National Judge and serving on several committees.

Dan's Commodore year, 2003, was the Bicentennial of the State of Ohio and also the 30th anniversary of he and Doris joining Mentor Harbor Yachting Club, their 40th wedding anniversary (celebrated during the

regatta), and the 30th anniversary of the van Heeckerens sailing at I-LYA Bay Week. In those years, his racing at the event was only interrupted twice – once when the boat had run aground returning from Mackinac Island, and the previous year when his Vice Commodore duties necessitated him staying ashore.

Following his year as Commodore, Dan & Doris became the co-Chairs for the I-LYA Junior Championships in 2004, chairing the event in 2005. The 2005 event attracted 176 junior sailors representing 24 I-LYA clubs – one of the largest in the history of Junior Bay. Dr. Dan was a driving force behind the change to the Club 420 as the doublehanded boat and the Laser Radial as the singlehanded boat for Junior Bay Week and the I-LYA Traveler Series - following the rest of the nation at the time and helping to elevate the level of competition for Lake Erie area junior sailors. The van Heeckeren Family Trophy is awarded annually to the winner of the Laser Radial Class at the I-LYA Junior Championships.

He was a mentor to many of the leaders of I-LYA who followed him and shared his love of the sport of sailing and racing on Lake Erie with friends and family throughout his life. Even throughout his battle with Parkinson's disease, Dan remained as active in I-LYA as possible. Dr. Daniel W. van Heeckeren passed away on June 9, 2020 in Shaker Heights, Ohio.

- **I-LYA** consists of 142 member clubs and every member of each club is automatically a member of I-LYA, and is assured recognition among other clubs.
- **I-LYA'S** membership includes clubs from both the United States and Canada, making for strong international ties and competitions.
- Member clubs are represented by delegates to **FLYA** and meet twice annually. Spring and fall meetings are held in the vicinity of the current Commodore. Class advisory, cruise and powerboat committees meet prior to the delegate's meeting, giving open forum for class improvement and rules enlightenment. Delegates elect the Flag Officers and Trustees at the Fall Meeting.
- **I-LYA** appoints delegates to US Sailing and Yacht Racing Union of the Great Lakes.
- **I-LYA** is governed by a nine member Board of Trustees. Business is conducted through the office of the Executive Secretary.

2019 U.S. Junior Championships

The Chubb U.S. Junior Championship, U.S. Sailing's National Championship for junior sailors aged 13-18, was held in 2019 in Redwood City, CA at the Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation. Nine I-LYA juniors qualified to compete based on their finishes at the Area E Championships which were held at Edgewater Yacht Club in early July. Five of the nine applied for and received Yachtsmen's Fund Championship Grants to help offset the expense involved with travel and participation while representing I-LYA.

Spencer Barnes and Will Carroll, both from Cleveland Yachting Club, competed for the Smythe Trophy in the Laser Radial fleet. This was Spencer's second trip to Nationals, having finished 17th in 2018. The experience certainly paid off. According to Spencer, "The sailing conditions (on San Francisco Bay) are just as good as they talked about. Up until the last day of the competition, winds, waves, and tides were absolutely 'blowin the hats off the gumbies.' On the last day, the conditions backed off and matched a more familiar pattern to me. I managed to secure a 1st and 4th allowing me to move up in the standings to finish 4th/20." Spencer, who won the Radial fleet at Junior Bay Week in 2018 switched things up in 2019 and sailed and won the C420 fleet with crew John Wynne. He also branched out into Thistles, VX One, and the J105 and is very appreciative of the skippers who let him "climb aboard and compete with them."

Some of the doublehanded competitors also benefitted from past experience. C420 skipper and Edgewater Yacht Club sailor Jack Vanderhorst who sailed a Lightning in 2018 returned in 2019 with his regular "Double Dutch" crew Daniel van Heeckeren to compete for the Bemis Trophy and finished 11th out of 20 boats. The Grosse Point Yacht Club team of Michael Kirkman and Zach Rockwell improved on their 10th place 2018 performance by finishing strong in 3^d place.

The three man team of Chad Schaffner, Jonathan Mack, and Will Thornton from Cleveland Yachting Club not only had to manage sailing in tides and cur-

rents on the open waters of San Francisco Bay, they also had to quickly adjust to an asymmetrical boat as racing for the coveted Sears Cup was held in Open 5.7s. While they did not finish where they had hoped, they learned a lot and met many excellent junior sailors from around the country.

The U.S. Junior Women's Doublehanded and Singlehanded Championships were also held in California in 2019. Sara and Annie Schumann, representing Cowan Lake Sailing Association, Nadia Reynolds from Hoover Sailing Club and the Grosse Point Yacht Club team of Anna Carron and Eva Paschke competed for the Ida Lewis Trophy in San Diego in July. Emma Friedauer, Hoover Sailing Club, and Siri Schantz, Leatherlips Yacht Club, took advantage of two days of coaching and three days of racing for the Leiter Trophy in Richmond, CA.

While all 2020 Championships have been cancelled due to Covid-19. Sailors should plan now for 2021 and remember that the Yachtsmen's Fund has Championship Grants and Challenge Team Grants available to help support travel outside our I-LYA footprint.




JAM Boat of the Year







I-LYA is monitoring the incidence of COVID-19 and will be following guidance from local health departments and the State of Ohio. Be aware that regatta events this year may be altered to accommodate the current restrictions.









Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, hand held GPS and electronic chart instruction, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position using hand held GPS as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

On-the-Water (Four contests using inflatables)

"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings and identify your position using hand held GPS. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.

Chicane This is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in 2 directions without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.

Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

Social Competitions

In addition to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

Geo-Quest

Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

Cardboard Boat Race

Who *doesn't* love making stuff with duct tape? Juniors combine their engineering skills with construction and boating knowlege. Entrants must be 12–17, pre-assembly is allowed, each boat to be designed for 1 or 2 people. Awards given to place finishers and a "Spirit Award" given to the team showing greatest Team Spirit and "The Titanic Award" to the boat that sinks in spectacular fashion. Bring your own cardboard and tape. NO materials will be provided by the committee.

Fishing Derby

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1^{st} , 2^{d} or 3^{d} place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2^d & 3^d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.

Power Contests

Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events have been selected by the committee which provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and the winner's name will be placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy is an individual award and will be awarded to an *individual* competing in the various events NOT to a competing team. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

Predicted Log

The Predicted Log is a boat handling contest. A contestant's knowledge of their boat's performance and good navigation skills are necessary. A predetermined course is designed around a set of *control points*; which include buoys, markers, and landmarks, which must be passed on the port or starboard side of the boat, as designated. A contestant's calculation of his/her predicted log requires the contestant to plot the designated course on his/her own chart and predict the elapsed time, in minutes and seconds, that he/she will pass each control point. Contestants must run the course at their chosen speed, higher than six knots; their prediction should be based on their chosen speed. The use of GPS is allowed when running the course. However the use of auto-pilot during the contest is strictly prohibited. Contestants should know their boat's compass deviation, as most control points are not visible from the start of a leg. The Predicted Log committee will assign an impartial observer to accompany the contestant during the run. Each contestant is asked to bring at least one observer, who will be assigned to another contestant's boat. A short training class will be held for observers before the start of the contest. Each contestant must furnish two watches able to read in hours, minutes and seconds.

Committee Distance 17 NM

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is not intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete, and if eligible, only one flag will awarded to the team captain. Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 PM) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

Social Competitions

R: ANY CONTRACTOR OF A CONTRAC

Social competitions include the East vs. West Volleyball, the co-ed Softball Game, and senior Corn Hole. Volleyball takes place on the PIBYC grounds and the softball game, at the school. Because most of the participants play these games only once a year, the spectators usually get a good laugh from the week-end warriors but occasionally see some impressive athleticism. The rivalry is sometimes intense but always good-natured. A trophy is naturally awarded to the victors but bragging rights are the real "Gold Medal" that is sought. The cardboard boat races are also a source of "titanic" good fun.

General Information

- The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- 3. The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- 6. Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- 7. Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's desk located at PIBYC.




