Dennis and I have enjoyed meeting many new people this year and we hope that you will join us at the Bay in 2019. Here's to a great boating season. We hope to see you all soon!





2019 Commodore Cindy Johnson-Mintus hails from Fremont, Ohio where she grew up on the Sandusky River. Cindy lived near the Memory Marina, which is now known for the fun hot spot, Jimmy Buckets! In her early years, Cindy's entire family lived on or near the Sandusky River in the small community of Wightman's Grove. She was very lucky in that she grew up with access to the water and enjoyed boating, fishing and activities on the water all summer long.

Cindy relocated to Akron, Ohio in the late 90s with her children Amber and Craig. Cindy's career in Public Accounting took her away from the water for a brief time but her love of the outdoors prevailed, and she continued to boat with friends on Lake Erie enjoying water skiing, fishing and trips to Put-in-Bay.

Port Clinton Yacht Club

Very early in the 1900s, a lovely wooded area existed north of the Portage River, near to stores across the river and accessible by a short walk across an iron swing bridge. After crossing the bridge, one would follow a path to an area with a small building owned by the US Government. A small group of gentlemen felt this area would be a perfect location for them, their wives, and children to find swimming and boating fun. The gentlemen petitioned the federal government to lease this property. Finally, upon successful negotiations, the small building on the property was remodeled into a clubhouse.

In 1916 the first constitution and bylaws of the Port Clinton Yacht Club were adopted which included specific language for the promotion of yachting. During the 1920s the club saw many changes that included purchasing the leased land from the government, building a new clubhouse, building our first caretakers house and the dredging of the boat basin.

After WWII the club received its first liquor license and the clubhouse underwent extensive renovations that included indoor plumbing. In 1947, the first sail regatta, "Snow Flurries Race" was established.


As the club continued to grow, so did a need for a new clubhouse and in 1961 the building, which stands today, was dedicated. In 1962 the first "Green Island Race" was held on Labor Day weekend and the first "no pets" rule was adopted due to an incident with a visiting boater and his pet monkey. In 1971, our first pool was completed which caused a great stir as many members couldn't understand why we needed a pool with the lake so near. High lake levels had been problematic at times which prompted the club to build a dyke on the shores of the lake to prevent it from washing into the lagoon. The docks and grade of the grounds have since been raised to prevent flooding.

As the club grew so did membership numbers and the need for more docks—leading to the 1980s construction of

the east jetty at the entrance to the lagoons, an addition to the clubhouse of a kids' room, and a major remodel including installation of central air conditioning.

In the 1990s PCYC experienced great change at the club including a constitutional change (1993) accepting female membership. PCYC now offers family memberships and our membership limit has grown to 525 members. In the mid-2000s the club purchased additional lakefront property increasing size of our footprint on the shores of Lake Erie. We are now a pet friendly facility and in 2016 completed a state-of-the-art pool.

Today, our members enjoy the pool, waterslides and two sand beaches, tennis, shuffle board, sailing, boating, large marina, social activities and beautiful clubhouse overlooking the Portage River. We offer abundant green space for social gatherings and picnics and all of our docks offer drive up space for cars. Both the Power and Sail Fleet offer multiple social, learning, cruising and racing events. PCYC is the host club and organizing authority for One-Design Championships, I-LYA regattas, I-LYA Traveler Series regattas, and Club Racing. The club hosts the Green Island Regatta each Labor Day weekend and the Snow Flurries Regatta in late September each year. Our year-round social calendar offers plenty of activities to enjoy and our bar, lounge and kid's room are open 361 days a year. Nestled, on 11 acres of land, between the shores of Lake Erie and the Portage River, we are truly the "Greatest Club on the Great Lakes."



Yachtsman of the Year

Commodore Dennis Mintus

Each spring since the tradition was started in 1978, it is the responsibility of the Commodore to select an individual as the Yachtsman of the Year. Historically Speaking

I-LYA 125 Years Ago (1894)

I-LYA was reorganized on March 19, 1894. This was the beginning of its present uninterrrupted run. Charter members were the Buffalo Yacht Club, Citizen's Yachting Association of Detroit, Cleveland Yacht Club, Erie Yacht Club, Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, Toledo Yacht Club and the West End Yacht Club of Detroit.

George W. Gardner was again elected commodore. E.W. Radder of Cleveland, the man who would spearhead the drive to create the North American Yacht Racing Union in 1896, secretary-treasurer.

Feature event was the race for the World Cup, placed into competition by the Cleveland newspaper of the same name. There were 15 starters in the handicap class. The winner was *Chinook* of Sandusky. Naphtha launch races were listed in the regatta circular and the winner was *Restless* with its 6 HP engine. Sail yachts were rated under a handicap rule that provided, "The gross measurement of boats shall be determined by adding together the waterline length, the beam and depth of hull at the mast." The time allowance was 2 seconds for each foot difference in measurement per mile.

I-LYA 100 Years Ago (1919)

R. George Marsh of Grosse Pointe Yacht Club was I-LYA's commodore during 1919. Fred W. Wakefield of Vermilion Boat Club was vice commodore with Fred Emmons of Sandusky Yacht Club rear commodore. Hugh Gunnison of Erie Yacht Club was chairman of the Yachtsmen's Fund. The carnival committee arranging the annual Mardi Gras was T.B. Alexander, mayor of Put-in-Bay.

Regatta dates were July 13–19. Sunday was reserved for the yachtsmen's dinner at Hotel Crescent. Tuesday was picked for the "Joy Fest" of the Marsh Mud Hens. On Wednesday, the Cleveland Yacht Club band presented a concert while a reception was held aboard illuminated yachts. The commodore's ball was set for Thursday at Hotel Victory. Shore sports included rope climbing, ball throwing, baseball and foot races for ladies and men. The Yachtsmen's Fund provided cash prizes for sailing events. Hotel Victory offered a gift of \$100 to any I-LYA yachtsman naming its main ballroom. It is unknown if a name was ever chosen as this was the year that fire destroyed the Victory and marked the end of an era at Put-in-Bay.

I-LYA 75 Years Ago (1944)

An Edison Boat Club commodore, Joseph F. Nagel, was commodore of I-LYA during 1944. James A. Beidler, Jr., of Toledo Yacht Club was vice commodore with Lester R. Mylander of Sandusky Yacht Club rear commodore. Lee Miller of Put-in-Bay Yacht Club was president of the trustees. Commodore A.F. Wakefield of Vermilion Boat Club headed the Yachtsmen's Fund with Commodore Earl V. Seitz of Sandusky Yacht Club as its secretary-treasurer. Regatta dates were August 6–9.

The Commodore's Reception was held on the lawn at Lonz's Winery on Middle Bass Island. Climax of the entertainment, following the "Commodore's Follies," a variety show staged on a barge moored in the bay, was a spectacular fireworks display. Popular boats of the 23 classes racing were the 8-meters, sixes, Rs, 30-square meters, Stars and Lightnings. The nation was at war but top officials urged that the regatta go on as recreation was a necessary factor in the war effort.

Shamrock (Kerr-Wunsch Syndicate) of Bayview Yacht Club won among the eights. Noreg (Gordon Sanders) topped the sixes. Commodore Alexander Winton, Jr., of Cleveland Yacht club was the R-class champ with Puffin. Walt Swindeman of Toledo's Bay View Yacht Club was the Lightning king with Yankee Doodle. Russell Moore's La Salle from TYC and Al Edgerton's Robin from CYC finished the R class opener in a photo finish so close it took a vote of the judges to decide the winner.

A Nor'easter with heavy seas played havoc with the fleet in the opening race. The Detroit Boat Club committee boat, part of the spectator fleet, burned to the water's edge.


I-LYA 50 Years Ago (1969)

Henry J. Schuck of Edison Boat Club was elected to I-LYA's helm for 1969 by the 97 member clubs. His fellow officers were V/C Virl F. Berry of Cleveland's Forest City Yacht Club, and R/C Arthur N. O'Hara of Vermilion Boat Club. Once again, spring and fall meetings were held in Detroit's Hotel Whittier.

1969 was the year Commodores Earl Seitz of Sandusky Yacht Club and Al Wakefield of Vermilion Boat Club passed away. Both had served I-LYA capably and long including each having served as president of the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.



Dates were July 26–31 for Junior Race Week and August 2–7 for the traditional regatta, both held at Put-in-Bay. The commodore's dinner was at the newly renovated Colonial Pavilion where the commodore's ball was also held. The only powerboat event was the predicted log contest for the Greeley Trophy.

Over 200 sail yachts

competed in 29 classes. John Mueller of CYC was a clean sweeper in the Lightning Class Championships, Commodore Frank Miller of PIBYC repeated his sweep in the K Class. Bernie Swindeman of North Cape Yacht Club won the Dragon Class title with *Appleknocker*. Dan Howley of VBC was the top Jet-14 skipper. Robert Seltzer's *Catastrophe* from SSC was the Cruising-A winner. George Sackett III from Mentor Harbor Yachting Club became I-LYA's junior sailing champion.

I-LYA 25 Years Ago (1994)

1994 marked the 101st I-LYA Regatta launching our second century of yachting. The organization started with 9 but now had 130 member clubs. Its commodore was a Thistle sailor from Sandusky Sailing Club, Harold H. Christenson, who was born and raised in North Dakota. After graduating NDS in Fargo with a degree in

Mechanical Engineering, he worked his entire career at the National Advisory Committee of Aeronautics that later became NASA, retiring in 1977. Harold's boating activities started in 1964 with the purchase of Thistle #1108 and the joining of Sandusky Sailing Club and later its Commodore in 1978. Vice commodore was Clay Mock from Mentor Harbor Yachting Club and rear commodore was Mike Smith from Sandusky Yacht Club.



Jim Crain, PIBYC

At I-LYA's Spring meeting, held at the Sandusky Radisson, this year's "Man of the Year" was honored for four decades of dedication and volunteer service to I-LYA. Recruited in the 1950s to serve as a patrol boat on the Junior Sears Cup course by Jack Springer of SSC, Jim Crain stayed on to set marks for the Junior and Senior regattas and Deepwater

races, help with the Predicted Log competitions, pen sailing instructions for Juniors and One-designs, and serve as I-LYA Trustee, Executive Secretary, and Yachtsman Fund Secretary/Treasurer.

The K Cruise started July 6 at Fairport Harbor. The 10-day cruise went to Pt. Stanley, Ontario at the Kanagio Yacht Club and on to Erie Yacht Club and then to Dunkirk Yacht Club. The next stop was across the lake to the Marlon Marina at Pt. Colborne, back across the lake to Commodore Perry Yacht Club, then to Ashtabula Yacht Club.

The 39th I-LYA Jr. Race Week was Sunday July 17– 22 with Roger & Judy Fair from Sandusky Sailing Club as chairpersons and Chris & Lin Bartel from Mentor Harbor Yachting Club as vice chairs. Top Thistle sailors were Tom Campbell, Andrew Rushing, and Bob Seiwart from Leatherlips Yacht Club. Flying Juniors were led by James Lipp and Mike Kaim from Mentor Harbor Yachting Club and Matt Disch, Cleveland Yachting Club, won top Laser honors.

The 1994 regatta was held at Put-in-Bay July 23–31. Registration fees ranged from \$40 for one-design centerboard classes to \$265 for boats over 40 feet, a considerable jump from 1979 when centerboard fees were \$9 and boats sailing Courses 4 & 5 (around the islands) was \$20. The Blue Gavel Trophy IOR and PHRF Boat of the Year was LEORC *Bullet* Jim Sampson, Sandusky Sailing Club. Two important milestones were reached—40 years of the Crescent class and 50 years for the Thistles.

The Powerboat Regatta ran from Thursday July 28 to Sunday July 31 with Jim Bridge, Ottawa River Yacht Club, as chairman. There were 391 boats registered with the yacht club with the Greatest Participation being South Shore Cruising Club. The Greeley Trophy (predicted log) and the Commodores Trophy (Predicted Log, docking, chicane, and weather forecasting) both went to Dennis Mintus, *Derelict Too*, of Ashtabula Yacht Club.

I-LYA 10 Years Ago (2009)

The Commodore of I-LYA's 147 member clubs was Ed Payne from Ford Yacht Club, with vice commodore John Stewart, WRYCC, and rear commodore Fred Schroeder, CCYC, completing the Bridge.

The 54th Annual I-LYA Jr. Bay Week at Put-in-Bay ran Sunday July 19 to Friday July 24 with Matt & Tracy Davis from Buckeye

Lake YC as chairpersons. The 2009 Jr. Bay Week hosted 159 kids from 19 clubs. Top sailors were Thistle: William Weible, Jack Hunger and Evan Graves, Cleveland YC; 420: Mike Gemperline and CJ Seidman, Edgewater YC; Laser full rig: Timothy Zacher, Vermilion BC; Laser Radial rig/vanHeeckeren Trophy: Hannah Fisher, Indianapolis SC. This was also the 1st year of "Wacky Wednesday" on the 420 course.

This year the Yachts*man* of the Year became Yachts*persons* of the Year with a tribe of recipients: Commodore Henry Webber and Lady Peggy, Commodore Clay Mock, Commodore Byron Kosino, and Lady Donna Payne.




Derelict Too

P o w e r b o a t Regatta started Wed. July 29 with John Dalessandro, Wyandotte YC, as chairman. Power overlapped into Sail Regatta's August 1st Deepwater, not clearing the docks

until 10 A.M. on the 2^d. The Greeley Trophy for Predicted Log and Commodores Trophy was the same as 10 years earlier: Dennis Mintus of Ashtabula YC on *Derelict Too* being the winner. Junior Navigation honors and the \$400 scholarship went to Brittany Greenwood, Harbor View Yacht Club.

Deepwater finishers started filling the docks August 1st. The Sunday Deepwater awards took place at the Crescent Patio, registration at the Winter Bar at the Park Hotel, and Commodores Brunch was held at Mary Ann McCann's home, the *Anchorage*. A parade to the Commodores' Memorial for the opening ceremony took place Sunday afternoon. After Monday's racing, the Rum Party was held at the Crews Nest Pavilion. After Wednesday's racing the Regatta Series Award Presentation was at PIBYC. Boats cleared the docks by Thursday 10 A.M.

Loss between '08 and '09 was great with the passing of I-LYA Commodores Frank Olech, BPYC and Bill Heider, CPYC and 2-term Trustee and President from 1992–94, Paul Pheiffer, SYC.



Celebrating 100 Years


2019 marks the 100th anniversary of the incorporation of The Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund. The Fund was originally founded in 1919 to provide financial support to the fledgling Inter-Lake Yachting Association and has a rich and storied history of supporting I-LYA sailors, powerboaters, clubs and organizations throughout its first 100 years of existence. In 1986, the IRS qualifying letter renewed the charitable status of the Fund as a 501(c)3 organization whose mission is to raise money to be used for education and activities which would enhance the knowledge, safety, and enjoyment of sailing and power boating, primarily for youth.

Under the leadership of President Monica Bloomstine of Erie Yacht Club, with the continued mentorship of immediate Past President Clay Mock of Edgewater Yacht Club and with the guidance of the other nine trustees, the Fund continues to offer financial assistance to a wide array of both junior sailors and junior power boaters within the I-LYA community, while striving to grow their endowment to levels which will allow the Fund to prosper far into the future.

To celebrate this anniversary, the Fund kicked off a special Centennial Campaign in December of 2018. Limited edition gold and silver hued pins are being awarded in recognition of a donation of \$1000 (gold) or \$100 (silver). The pins are unique, featuring the I-LYF logo and the 1919–2019 designation and will only be available for this campaign.

Some of the more recent activities of The Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund in support of our mission include: sharing in the purchase of 10 handheld GPS units for use during the I-LYA Junior Power Regatta; keeping Junior Bay Week affordable through Housing and Coaching Grants; awarding of scholarships to qualifying I-LYA junior sailors and power-boaters; and providing Championship Grants to junior sailors who represent I-LYA at Chubb Nationals. New in 2019, the Fund has created Training Grants to encourage certification for instructors and race management in I-LYA.

It is the belief of the Fund that our youth, both sailors and power boaters, are the future of our sport. It is imperative that we all do all we can to support their education, growth, and development, and to instill in them a love of the sport of sailing and powerboating, so they too can enjoy the life-long benefits that we as adults have realized. With a successful 100th Anniversary Centennial Campaign, the trustees and members of the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund hope to be able to provide even more assistance and play an even bigger role in the future of the I-LYA as we move forward into the next 100 years.

Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, hand held GPS and electronic chart instruction, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position using hand held GPS as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

On-the-Water (Four contests using inflatables)

"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings and identify your position using hand held GPS. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.

Chicane This is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in 2 directions without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.





Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

Social Competitions

In addtion to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

Geo-Quest

Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

Cardboard Boat Race

Who *doesn't* love making stuff with duct tape? Juniors combine their engineering skills with construction and boating knowlege. Entrants must be 12–17, pre-assembly is allowed, each boat to be designed for 1 or 2 people. Awards given to place finishers and a "Spirit Award" given to the team showing greatest Team Spirit and "The Titanic Award" to the boat that sinks in spectacular fashion. Bring your own cardboard and tape. NO materials will be provided by the committee.

Fishing Derby

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1st, 2^d or 3^d place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2d & 3d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.

Power Contests

Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events were selected by the committee, which are thought to provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) of these contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file in order to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and your name placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is kept in the Boaters' Museum at Put-in-Bay. The trophy is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy will be awarded to an individual competing in the various events. The trophy will NOT be awarded to a competing team. This is an individual award NOT a team award. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

Predicted Log

The Predicted Log is a boat handling contest. A contestant's knowledge of their boat's performance and good navigation skills are necessary. A predetermined course is designed around a set of control points; which include buoys, markers, and landmarks, which must be passed on the port or starboard side of the boat, as designated. A contestant's calculation of his/her predicted log requires the contestant to plot the designated course on his/her own chart and predict the elapsed time, in minutes and seconds, that he/she will pass each control point. Contestants must run the course at their chosen speed, higher than six knots; their prediction should be based on their chosen speed. The use of GPS is allowed when running the course. Contestants should know their boat's compass deviation, as most control points are not visible from the start of a leg. The Predicted Log committee will assign an impartial observer to accompany the contestant during the run. Each contestant is asked to bring at least one observer, who will be assigned to another contestant's boat. A short training class will be held for observers before the start of the contest. Each contestant must furnish two watches able to read in hours, minutes and seconds.

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is not intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete, and if eligible, only one flag will awarded to the team captain. Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 pm) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

Social Competitions

Social competitions include the East vs. West Volleyball, the co-ed Softball Game, and senior Corn Hole. Volleyball takes place on the PIBYC grounds and the softball game, at the school. Because most of the participants play these games only once a year, the spectators usually get a good laugh from the weekend warriors but occasionally see some impressive athleticism. The rivalry is sometimes intense but always good-natured. A trophy is naturally awarded to the victors but bragging rights are the real "Gold Medal" that is sought. The cardboard boat races are also a source of "titanic" good fun.

General Information

- 1. The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- 3. The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- 6. Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's desk located at PIBYC.






