

2011 Grand Islander Hotel Rules

1. Rooms are not to be rearranged. All furniture must stay in the rooms.
2. No alcohol or drugs permitted.
3. NO GUESTS in the rooms after 2230.
4. There is NO co-ed visitation allowed in the rooms – AT ANY TIME – including coaches!
5. No smoking, no candles, no incense, no burning of any materials is allowed.
6. There will be no ropes strung in rooms for any reason.
7. No wet clothes are to be hung on the furniture.
8. Only competitors may sleep in the rooms, at any time.
9. Lost keys. Chaperones (firewatch) can vouch for a competitor's identity, if known. If not, the competitor's yacht club's Parent of the Day or Team Liaison will have to come to the hotel to secure a replacement key for their team member.
10. Competitors are welcome to use the pool at the Islander Inn next door. Pool rules and regulations are posted at the pool. Competitors are NOT permitted at *Splash* at the Grand Islander Inn.
11. Any disruptive person(s) will be given one warning. After one warning, the person(s) responsible will be directed to the Regatta Chairmen to discuss the incident with possible withdraw from the regatta and expulsion from the island.
12. Chaperones (firewatch) are to at the hotel upon the arrival of the sailors from the races, return from scheduled activities and/or early release from PIBYC.
