

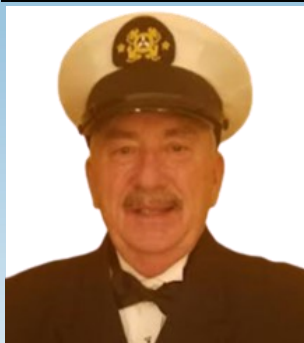

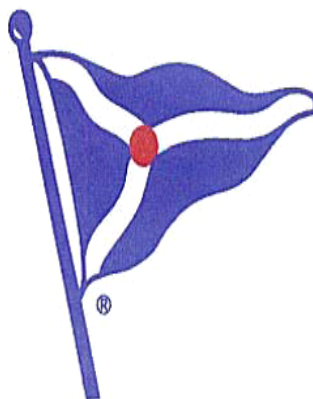

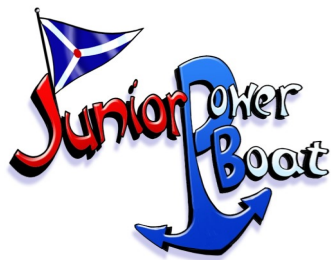
In closing, the boating season is upon us, travel safely on the water. Please consider a having a courtesy safety inspection for your boat. We will see you at The Bay!

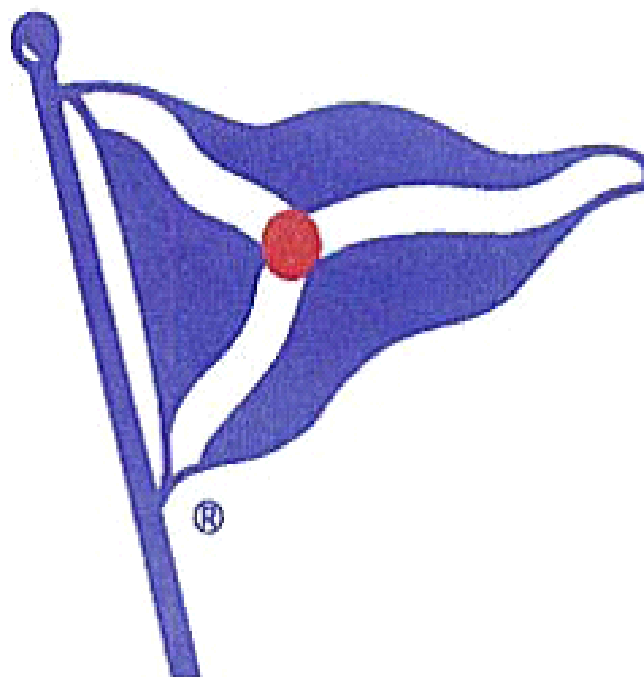
