Beginning with a small group of sailors looking for good waters and "bragging rights," I-LYA is now an association of 147 clubs, both power and sail, located

in 6 states and Canada. We are recognized as the US Sailing Regional Sailing Authority and Appeals Body for race protests in our area. We serve as a watchdog for proposed legislation affecting yachting and yachtsmen. And finally, I-LYA is privileged to host the Regatta which has been recognized as the oldest in North America running annually since the late 1800s.

All this is made possible by hard working member groups including The Board of Trustees, the Yachtsmen's Fund Board, each year's Bridge Members and the many committees that put together this yearbook, organize and manage events, and run the regattas. I have learned in the last two years how many unrecognized workers this organization has. I salute them all.

Senior Sail Regatta precedes Power Regatta this year and extends over a weekend. We are also working on improving our website and communications thru "I-LYA News" to share timely articles and information of interest to all our I-LYA members. Hopefully these changes will encourage greater participation and offer a great experience for those attending our Regattas.

This year we have also re-established an alliance begun 100 years ago when the Centennial of the Battle of Lake Erie was celebrated. We have partnered with the Perry Group to bring the Battle of Lake Erie to life during this Bicentennial year. Presentations about this year's events and displays were part of the Spring Meeting and an overview will be available at the Winter Meeting. Events will be featured throughout the year on our website. Be sure to check it on a regular basis and join in when possible. It's a once in a life time opportunity.

Meet the Commodore

This year's Commodore was born in Sharon Pennsylvania, the second oldest of nine children. Needless to say, his leadership abilities began to be displayed at a very young age. Those same friends "The Port Dalhousie Boys" introduced Kris to boating on another level with their annual trips which included the Welland Canal, up the river to Port Huron and Sarnia, and of course always stops at Put-in-Bay.

Kris and Reni felt so honored to be chosen that they never asked what the job entailed. Despite that fact, Kris went on to serve as the One Design Chairman for over 15 years and served four non consecutive terms on the Board of Trustees. Through the years, he has also served on the auditing committee, nominating committee, code of regulation committee, publications committee and the regatta support committee.

Although he is a Principle Race Officer for the sailing community, his family boat is a 30 foot Sea Ray. He enjoys taking the grandchildren out on the

week-ends and in recent years has begun traveling on the Great Lakes with Reni. Along the way they have made it a point to visit I-LYA clubs where they have always felt welcome.

Kris and Reni have especially enjoyed meeting club members while representing Inter-Lake Yachting Association at member clubs' functions this year. They are looking forward to this year's Regattas and to taking a part in the Bicentennial Celebration of the Battle of Lake Erie.

The Put-in-Bay Yacht Club

Put-in-Bay Yacht Club is one of the oldest yacht clubs on Lake Erie. It was founded as the Put-in-Bay Yachting Association on February 13, 1886 with Valentine Dollar as the organization's 1st Commodore. Originally, the association was formed by Put-in-Bay businessmen interested in welcoming yachtsmen to the island and promoting Inter-Lake Yachting Association's annual regatta. The association was re-formed in 1894 as Put-in-Bay Yacht Club. George W. Endrue served as PIBYC's 1st Commodore.

Early meetings were held in local boathouses. In 1923, PIBYC found a permanent home when Jack J. Day, who owned the old Bay View House which stood on the current side yard of the club, sold land and lake frontage to the club. The clubhouse was built soon after and a pavilion was

constructed in front along the shore. Originally, the club had a substantial dock, but it was destroyed many years ago by high water and winter ice.

After World War II, an expanding group of cottage owners became interested in the club and the club experienced new growth in all aspects. A Ladies Auxiliary was established in 1949. Through their efforts, sailing and swimming programs were established in 1950 and 1952. Soon after, a Saturday Sailing Series was started and a fleet of small sailboats began to grow. A galley and shower rooms were added to the club in 1953.

In the 1960's the clubhouse was again enlarged and remodeled. An addition to the back allowed for larger social events and better facilities for the sailing and swimming classes. The Auxiliary installed commercial grade equipment in the galley and purchased furniture. An "L" was added to the dock and additional land was purchased behind the club.

In the 1970's, additional improvements were made to the clubhouse and the grounds. In the early 1980's the front of the clubhouse was strikingly renovated, blending the old with the new. The property directly to the east was also obtained.

More change was the theme of the 1990's. The newly acquired side yard was nautically enclosed, landscaped and paved for parking. The back room was updated with a serving bar and storage cabinets, the galley further equipped, and the front room renewed.

As the Century came to a close, a major addition to the rear of the club offered excellent shower facilities, better storage, and a club office. The front room was enlarged and guest restrooms installed.

The early 2000's brought more renovations and restructured operations with full-time staff. Liquor and food licenses were obtained. Friday suppers and gourmet dinners began. A bar was added to the front room, offering a lounge area for members, guests, and affiliates. An outdoor patio was laid and new docks were constructed enabling PIBYC to offer transient guest docks to all club visitors (available by reservation). In the past 127 years the club and its physical properties have changed, yet still continue to fulfill the original mission by hosting local and national sail and power regattas and welcoming I-LYA and AYC members to the island.







Historically Speaking

I-LYA 50 years ago (1963):

George Glitsch Llewellyn of Lorain Yacht Club became I-LYA Commodore in 1963. Frank H. Miller of Put-in-Bay and Buckeye Lake Yacht Club was Vice-Commodore and William H. Miller of Vermilion Yacht Club the Rear Commodore. Robert Trinter of Lorain was Secretary-Treasurer and Roger E. Doane of Lorain the General Chairman of Junior Race Week.

Powerboat racing was not too popular and was practically limited to predicted log contests but the sailing regatta blossomed with 32 classes ranging from Cruising-A to Lyman Cats. They represented I-LYA's 91 member clubs with 20,000 members owning 13,000 boats. Regatta dates were Aug. 4–8 with the usual Deep Water Races preceding but with races from Port Clinton, Sandusky, and Vermilion added.

Completely revised rules went into effect for the cruising sail yacht classes, including the requirement to measure a yacht's "inclined righting moment." (Things were so simple 50 years ago.) Commodore Sidney Frohman's plush lodge on the island became the Yachtsmen's Club, a commercial boatel facility that was fated to be short-lived.

Lee C. Howley Jr. of Vermilion Yacht Club was the Junior Race Week champion. Don Southam of Edgewater took three firsts in the Highlander Class. Jack Mueller took the Lightning Class title as his father, John, had done in 1962. Commodore Frank H. Miller won his fifth straight K Class crown. Walt Swindeman of Toledo won in the *Dragons* and Hank Burkard's *Meteor II* of Bayview Yacht Club won in Cruising-A.

Commodore Llewellyn wound up his regatta with a sesquicentennial program marking the 150th anniversary of Commodore Oliver Hazard Perry's victory off Put-in-Bay in the War of 1812, capped by a dinner at Port Clinton's Island House Hotel to which most of the area's important brass was invited. Commodore Llewellyn had a penchant for doing things in a big way, but the party placed quite a strain on I-LYA.

I-LYA 75 years ago (1938):

Leading I-LYA for 1938 was Wilbur J. Wright from Cleveland Yachting Club. He was ably assisted by Dr. A.R. Hackett of Detroit Yacht Club, Vice Commodore, and Joseph W. Harbrecht from Sandusky Yacht Club as Rear Commodore.

The annual Regatta was held at Put-in-Bay Aug. 7–10, with the Deep Water Races from Detroit, Toledo, and Cleveland. Flagship for the Regatta was the USCG Cutter

Tahoma where the Commodore's Reception was held on Monday afternoon. Entertainment for the evening was provided by the Sandusky Sailing Club with their "Foamy-Cherry-Chanty Chat."

Sailing were 21 classes from R sloops to Snipes. The powerboats were presented with the Alton H. Greely Trophy for the winner of the predicted log. Bob Greely sponsored this in memory of his father and was intended to garner national and international competition.

I-LYA 100 years ago (1913):

This was the Centennial of Oliver Hazard Perry's victory over the British on Lake Erie. I-LYA held a Commodore's Ball at Anderson's Academy on Euclid Avenue in Cleveland. George H. Worthington from Cleveland Yachting Club was Commodore and it was the year that the Lakewood and Cleveland Yacht Clubs merged. The Winton Trophy was placed in competition for the long distance race from Rocky River to Put-in-Bay. It was a two-legged affair with the first leg to Vermilion and the next to the Bay after an overnight stop. Commodore Worthington invited I-LYA members to sail aboard his flagship *Pricilla* on Memorial Day in Cleveland. In a downpour 75 guests showed up and left the East Ninth Street pier on schedule.

Over the summer of 1913, the never-ending celebration continued. It included a "Centennial Regatta" (under the auspices of the I-LYA) that featured sailing and powerboat regattas and an appearance by the yacht Pricilla. There were aviation events, swimming competitions and canoe races with trophies and ribbons galore! The annual Regatta was held July 20–25 at Put-in Bay, where the streets were lit electrically for the very first time. From the 4th of July to the formal celebration of the centenary of the Battle of Lake Erie on Sept. 10, Put-in-Bay was the scene of daily patriotic activities of the centennial period. Many patriotic societies, educational institutions, military and industrial organizations held their annual meetings on the island and half a million people visited the slowly rising memorial. The *Niagara* twice visited the ancient harbor during this period remaining from two to five days in port and was received with enthusiasm on both visits. The marine interest of the summer centered in the Perry's centennial regattas under the auspices of the Inter-Lake Yachting Association. A program of four weeks was devoted to regattas. sail yachts, power boats, aviation, rowing, canoeing, swimming and other sports were part of the Regatta and many of the events included national as well as inter lake participants.



- **I-LYA** consists of 147 member clubs and every member of each club is automatically a member of I-LYA, and is assured recognition among other clubs.
- **I-LYA'S** membership includes clubs from both the United States and Canada, making for strong international ties and competitions.
- Member clubs are represented by delegates to **I-LYA** and meet twice annually. Spring and fall meetings are held in the vicinity of the current Commodore. Class advisory, cruise and powerboat committees meet prior to the delegate's meeting, giving open forum for class improvement and rules enlightenment. Delegates elect the Flag Officers and Trustees at the Fall Meeting.
- **I-LYA** appoints delegates to US Sailing, Yacht Racing Union of the Great Lakes, and Western Lake Erie Cruising Association.
- **I-LYA** is governed by a nine member Board of Trustees. Business is conducted through the office of the Executive Secretary.
- **I-LYA** seeks corporate sponsorship to improve the services provided to its members and to control costs. Current sponsors include, BoatU.S., Mount Gay Rum, Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, TrueCourse Captain's School and West Marine.
- **I-LYA'S** Annual Regatta is held at Put-in-Bay, on South Bass Island, in western Lake Erie- the site of the historic Battle of Lake Erie in the War of 1812. It draws more than 500 Sail and Power boats annually.
- **I-LYA** has a permanent yachting display at the museum of the Lake Erie Islands Historical Society on Put-in-Bay.





Final Voyage

Commodore Gus Schell was born the son of German immigrants in Columbus, Ohio in 1912. He began his lifelong career in the theatrical business, working in the company his father founded, Schell Scenic Studio, at the age of eight. An "All Ohio Athlete," Gus excelled on the baseball team and as quarterback on the football team at Central High School in Columbus, where he was also President of the Class of 1931. While his career was in theater, his interests and activities were very diverse. He enjoyed celebrating his German heritage as a member of the Columbus Maennerchor Men's Chorus and also sang with the "Singing Buckeyes" Barbershop Quartet. His love of sport extended into his adult life throughout which he encouraged sportsmanship in many young central Ohio athletes; he served as President of the Columbus Agonis Club in 1972, was on the board of the Ernie Godfrey Chapter of the National College Football Hall of Fame, a life member of the Central Ohio Home Plate Club, a lifelong supporter of Ohio State Athletics, and a constant source of support and encouragement for the junior sailing programs of both I-LYA and the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club.

Gus' life was dedicated to service to others above all else. In addition to his professional, sports, and yachting activities, Gus was very active in numerous service organizations throughout his life. He was a veteran life member of the Charity Newsies in Columbus and a member of Rotary International.

Gus joined the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club in 1946 and served as Commodore in 1951. His service to both the Club and the boating community continued up until his death. He was recognized with BLYC's highest honor—the Heber Yachtsman Merit Trophy for sportsmanship, seamanship, and character—in 1963 and was perpetually honored in 2000 when the Club created the Commodore Gustav Schell Award—"The Gussie"—which is given annually to an Officer or Past Commodore who best exemplifies his example of continued and exceptional service to the Club and affiliated organizations. Gus was also an active member in the Columbus Sail & Power Squadron, the local flotilla of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, the Navy League of the United States, the Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, and many other boating associations and clubs.

Gus was most proud, however, to serve as the Commodore of I-LYA in 1975. In that same year, he and his crew on board Cat's Paw won the "Ghost Trophy" as the winner of the K-boat class in the annual Sail Regatta. Gus continued to be very active in I-LYA up into his 90's, never missing a meeting, serving as an emeritus member of the Board of Trustees of the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund, on the Advisory Committee, and attending and participating in all three regattas—juniors, power, and sail—through 2008. Many I-LYA members will recall enjoyable afternoons and conversations on the front porch of the Dodge House with he and Martha, his service on the Race Committee, his quick wit, and his continued support of both I-LYA and its officers. Gus will truly be missed.

David LeRoyd Shaffer passed away peacefully at his home in Toledo on May 11, 2012. Born August 11, 1941 in Marion, OH to M. LeRoyd and Ethel Shaffer, he was a 1959 graduate of Mt. Gilead High School and graduated in 1964 from Ohio Northern University where he was a member of Sigma Pi fraternity. Dave and Barbara were married in 1965 and settled down to raise their two boys, John and Chris. In the mid '70s John Greiner introduced the Shaffers to sailing and the family purchased their first boat, a Catalina 27 named *Moody Blue*. With two active boys a larger boat was soon needed and *Moody Blue* was replaced by a Catalina 34, *Wooly Bully*.

Dave was an active and then honorary member of Jolly Roger Sailing Club where he was commodore in 1987. He has been a member of North Cape Yacht Club since the mid 1980's and St. Petersburg Yacht Club since he and Barbara began spending their winters in Florida. Belonging to more than one club created additional racing and social opportunities and they made innumerable long lasting friendships within each organization.

Dave was extremely involved in I-LYA for over 25 years. He and his wife Barbara were Junior Race Week Chairmen in 1985 and worked that year to facilitate the combination of the Sears, Bemis and Smythe quarterfinals into a single event. He served several terms on the Board of Trustees and was elected for a term as president of the board. He was a member of the nominating committee and served as the chairman. Dave became commodore of Inter-Lake Yachting Association in 1990 and was selected as I-LYA Man of the Year in 2001. He served as executive secretary to the board for more than 10 years.

Dave was the I-LYA delegate to the U.S. Sailing Association, a U.S. Sailing Certified National Race Officer and a Certified Senior Judge. He also conducted classes for U.S. Sailing certified race officers in the area. Dave was the principle race officer for many national championship regattas including the Interlakes, Thistles, Lightnings, Highlanders and J35s. He was also the PRO on many, many weekend races for North Cape Yacht Club and Jolly Roger Sailing Club, for I-LYA Junior Bay Week and junior regattas at NCYC and JRSC, and for many races in the winter at St. Petersburg Yacht Club.

Dave was first a racer then a race officer. He knew what the sailors wanted at a regatta. You could count on Dave and his team of his wife Barb and Lou and Marti Johnson to run top notch regattas. Dave was also a competitor. He sailed through the years on *Moody Blue* and later *Wooly Bully*, competing in I-LYA's Bayweek Regattas and also in Mills Trophy Races. When he was not working the finish line at Put-in-Bay or serving on a committee, he could be found racing at NCYC on Wednesday nights.

Dave's leadership skills, devotion to duty, and positive attitude will be missed by I-LYA. But most of all, Dave will be sorely missed by sailors and friends for his attention to details on the water and his fun and laughter off the water. Sail on Dave.

I-LYA lost a dedicated visionary in September with the passing of Howard Pinkley. His relentless commitment to family, boating and community will be hard to replace. His accomplishments throughout his life speak for themselves and should remind us of the countless riches gained from giving.

Howard was born in Toledo on April 20, 1927 to Harold and Carrie Pinkley. His love of boating began at an early age on the Ottawa River. He built his first ice racer when he was in the sixth grade. Then, in the early 1940's, he and about 25 other local teens founded the Eureka Yacht Club when turned away as too young from the exiting clubs. He was also a co-founder of Jolly Roger Sailing Club.

After graduating from Waite High School in 1945, he enlisted in the Navy and later served in the Army. Upon returning from military service he became involved in the Associated Yacht Clubs where he was Commodore in 1958, and served as executive secretary 25 years. He was involved in I-LYA more than 50 years, serving as Delegate, and long-standing Chaplain. He was very active in the Regatta Support Committee. Howard volunteered many years for the race committee of the local one design sail races at various clubs. He also raced with his daughter Heidi in many races in the Cal 25 class.

He was a member of Ottawa River Yacht Club, life member; Toledo Ice Yacht Club, Past Commodore and life member; Riverview Yacht Club; Past Ole Man of the River; Monroe Boat Club, life member; North Cape Yacht Club, 35 years; and Toledo Yacht Club.

Howard was President of Flags Sales and Repairs since 1960. After starting the flag business at his home, he later moved to and renovated the former City Firehouse in Point Place into a showroom for his business of American and custom flags and banners. He started a group named "Flags for Point Place" which sets up 100 USA flags to decorate the community to show its pride for the service men and women. He worked with his daughter Wendy Beallas, who is continuing the tradition he so loved of American spirit and pride in his community.

After campaigning for support from the State of Ohio to promote the local waterways with a dock and kayak and canoe access, he was honored for the area to be named "Howard Pinkley Landing." This area now hosts weekly kayak and canoe races on the Ottawa River.

Howard was also very instrumental in the development of the Point Place Lighthouse and the Nautical Village Walkway, which was re-named Howard and Mary Pinkley Walkway after his passing. He was very proud to be a part of bringing the Tall Ships to Toledo, escorting them from Toledo Harbor Light to International Park.

Howard was preceded in death by his loving wife, Mary, of 52 years, and his brother Don Pinkley. He is survived by his three daughters Lauri Zunkiewicz, Heidi Germain and Wendy Beallas.

He touched so many lives. He changed so many things. His passions were contagious, and his memory is forever. Sail on, Howard. Sail on.

The Junior Traveler Series is a summer-long series of weekly regattas hosted by I-LYA member clubs throughout our region. The intent of the Traveler Series is to offer increased opportunities to race close to home. Series awards will be presented to the top finishing skippers and crew in each qualifying fleet based on the best five regatta finishes at any of the qualifying events. There is also a Team Trophy awarded each year to the top finishing club.

Eligibility

Sailors must be at least 7 years old and can participate in the Traveler Series up to and including the summer immediately following their senior year of high school. (Please note that age requirements for Junior Bay are different.) The following fleets are eligible for the series: Optimists, Laser Radials, Laser Full Rigs, C420s, and Thistles. Minimum participation levels for series scoring are defined in the Notice of Series available online under Junior Sailing at I-LYA.org. Also there are the requirements for the Thistle Szambecki Award.

Registration

Registration and scoring for the series and each qualifying regatta will utilize <u>noticeofrace.net</u>. Each participating sailor should register at the site and create a username and password. Complete instructions are available on the Traveler Series page at <u>I-LYA.org</u>. A series waiver and medical form must be filled out, signed, and presented at each event.

State Youth Concussion Law Compliance

I-LYA requires all clubs and coaches to comply with the appropriate youth concussion laws in the state where they are racing. Both Ohio and Michigan have online concussion training requirements. Please plan early to be in compliance. Complete details on the Traveler Series pages at I-LYA.org.



2012 Chubb Junior National Sailing Championships

The 2012 Chubb Junior National Sailing Championships were held on San Francisco Bay over August 8–10, 2012. Despite the unfamiliar conditions and distance involved, juniors representing the I-LYA participated in each of the three fleets sailed. For the first time, the single-handed finals were sailed in Byte C IIs, a laser-like rig with a high-tech look and sail. The double-handed boat remained the 420, and the J/22 was selected to be sailed for the Sears Cup as a quadruple-handed boat.

Participants qualified for the Finals in San Francisco based on their performance at the Area E Semi-finals, held in 2012 at Cowan Lake on the weekend prior to Junior Bay. The top two single-handed and double-handed boats were eligible to sail in the Finals, with only one boat from the triple-handed competition eligible to advance (and required to add a fourth team member to add

weight.) Four of the five qualifying boats at the Area E Semis were from I-LYA Clubs, and all qualifying I-LYA boats elected to participate in the Finals. Alec Chicoine of Hoover Sailing Club raced in the single-handed regatta. Mike Gemperline and Emily Schneider representing Edgewater Yacht Club, and Josie Sheehan and Ellen Snyder representing Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, each sailed in the 420 division. Finally, John Salisbury, Repton Salisbury, Christine Samanich and Colin McDowell representing The Cleveland Yachting Club sailed the J/22.

And what a National Championship it was! The conditions were described by the Race Committee as "the most challenging and complicated ever," with big air, tides, current, fog, and cold water facing the competitors every day. For Alec and the CYC Team, an unfamiliar boat was thrown in as an additional challenge. The Bytes and 420s

sailed a total of 10 races and the J/22s sailed 11 races over 3 days to complete the series. The entire group of juniors was complimented by the race officials for their "dazzling performance." The pictures tell the story!

A number of special events were planned off the water to add to the celebration, including a college sailing night and a special dinner with a presentation by the America's Cup promoters, held at the palatial St. Francis Yacht Club. It was truly a memorable regatta, topping all others with the exception of Junior Bay. This year's Junior National Championship will be sailed at Houston Yacht Club in Texas, so plan on competing at the Area E Semi-finals at Grosse Ile to try and win a spot.





OUPV: Known as the "6-Pack." Limited to 6 charter passengers on uninspected vessels (pleasure boats) up to 100GT.

TOW ENDORSEMENT: This course allows the OUPV and Licensed Master up to 200 tons to acquire a "Towing Endorsement" that permits them to engage in commercial assistant towing services for hire.

MASTER: For boats carrying more than 6 charter passengers that are U.S.C.G. inspected vessels.

SAIL ENDORSEMENT: This course allows the Master Captain to master a sailing vessel more than 6 passengers, or inspected boat.






Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatable's donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's Safe Boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.


Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

On-the-Water (Four contests using inflatables)

"Course A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.





Chicane The Chicane is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in both forward and reverse gears without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.

Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.







Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1st, 2^d or 3^d place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2d & 3d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.

Senior Power Contests

Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events were selected by the committee, which are thought to provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) of these contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file in order to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and your name placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is kept in the Boaters' Museum at Put-in-Bay. The trophy is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy will be awarded to an individual competing in the various events. The trophy will NOT be awarded to a competing team. This is an individual award NOT a team award. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting(20%).

Predicted Log and Navigation

Predicted Log & Navigation contest is a boat handling and navigation skill contest. Knowledge of your boat's performance along with piloting and navigational skills are a must. This is a two (2) part contest, with each contest being scored separately.

PART 1: Predicted Log A predetermined course established by the committee is designed around set "Control Points" (navigational aids, buoys, markers, landmarks) which must be passed or rounded, on either the port or starboard side. Calculating your "predicted Log" has been changed. New rules for a NO calculation predicted log is now approved by the committee. The contest will be run in or near the harbor allowing the use of an inflatable or other suitable small craft. The contestant will be required to maintain a constant speed and record the time at each mark. A two (2) man team is required, however only the captain of the team will be eligible for any award (flag) or entry into the Commodore's Trophy competition.

PART 2: Navigation Contest This is a contest designed to test the piloting and navigation skills of each contestant. You will be required to have a chart of the Islands in Lake Erie, road map for South Bass Island, hand bearing compass, stop watch or other time device equipped with a second hand, and basic plotting tools. This contest will take you on a trip around South Bass Island and you will be required to take bearings on distant objects from various observation points around the Island. You will be required to establish a fix on your

position or the theoretical position of another mariner and demonstrate your understanding of chart reading and plotting a course. The mode a transportation will be your choice (car, golf cart, bike or on foot).

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is NOT intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete in this event, only one (1) flag will be awarded (to the team captain). Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 PM) or as other wise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule; Please operate your vessel in a safe manner, remember: You are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

General Information

- 1. The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- 3. The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- 6. Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's deck located at PIBYC.

Meet our Sweet Marley



Our youngest granddaughter Marley was born with a very rare genetic disorder called Rhizomelic Chondrodysplasia Punctata or RCDP. RCDP is so rare that there are less than 100 children currently living with the disease. The statistics for RCDP are very grim. Most of the children affected by RCDP die before they reach their 2nd birthday and those that do survive, do so with profound mental and physical retardation and will most likely die before they are 5.

You can't tell by looking at her but Marley has had to fight for every developmental milestone. From smiling, rolling over, and crawling, everything in her first 3 years was a struggle. We watched her fight for these benchmarks that come so easily and naturally to most babies and we are reminded daily of the sanctity and importance of each life no matter what the medical diagnosis may be. When Marley was first diagnosed her parents (our kids) were told to take her home and put her on morphine and hospice because the likelihood of her surviving to a year old was very slim. Fortunately they chose not to listen to that Dr. and instead brought her home and enrolled her in every possible therapy they could. Over the course of her short life she has had nearly a dozen surgeries and hundreds of hours of therapy. We first give thanks to God for Marley's amazing progress but after that the credit goes to her phenomenal pediatrician and therapists. Marley is so blessed to be surrounded by a team of people who refuse to believe that a diagnosis is all that she is.

Marley is literally one in a million and we have no idea what her long term prognosis will be. The great thing about that is no one else knows either and Marley writes her own story page by page.


Our goal is to raise awareness for RCDP because the rarer a disease is the less likely it is that dollars will be raised to go towards research and a cure. RCDP is among the rarest of the rare.

There are a small handful of Dr's and researchers around the world who are interested in it but their hands are tied by lack of funds. Rhizokids International is a foundation that raises money to be put directly into these researchers hands. Each RCDP family has the hope that one day RCDP will be something that someone reads about in a text book and no longer a death sentence. We ask that you share Marley's story with your family and friends and cherish their health every day, and if your heart leads you, please help by donating to Rhizokids International.
