



It is my honor and privilege as Commodore to welcome you to the 121<sup>st</sup> I-LYA Regatta at Put-in-Bay. Recognized as the longest continuously running regatta in North America, our events at "the Bay," and our organization itself, represent a long tradition of cooperation and friendly competition amongst sailors and boaters. While the Sail Regatta began over a century ago, our activities have grown and expanded over the years—adding competition for junior sailors in 1956, powerboat competitions in the 1970s, and, more recently, junior powerboat training & competitions. 



### Meet the Commodore

Steve Harris' love for the outdoors and the water began at a very young age. As a child, he got his love for the outdoors and camping from his grandmother and his love for the water from his grandfathers. Weekends were often family picnics and afternoon sails at Buckeye Lake and family vacations were fishing trips to Lake Erie. Although sailing and boating were a part of his childhood, he did not get involved in the Yacht Club or sailboat racing until his late twenties. As a young adult, he spent his summers in the woods—working at summer camp. Of his 15 summers on camp staff, most were spent at various Boy Scout camps. Not able to escape the allure of Lake Erie, one summer he was the naturalist at the Kelley's Island 4-H Camp. It was through his involvement with summer camps that Steve came to join the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club.

As Camp Director in the mid-1990s, looking for a place for his campers to sail, Steve struck a deal with BLYC. They could use the camp's Laser sailboats for their junior sailing camps in exchange for storing and maintaining the boats and providing a facility for the Boy Scout camp's off-site sailing trip. This led to Steve running for the BLYC Board of Governors and being assigned the responsibility of Race, Regatta, & Junior Sailing. Over the several years he held this position, the Club's racing and junior programs grew and, of course, Steve became involved in I-LYA and Junior Bay Week. It was during these years that Steve came to know I-LYA P/C Gus Schell. With Gus' guidance and encouragement, Steve's involvement in both BLYC and I-LYA increased. It was also during this time that he first became a US Sailing certified race officer—beginning what has now become his primary involvement in the sport of sailing. Following his success in the sailing position, Steve moved into other positions on the BLYC board, eventually serving as Commodore of BLYC in 2005. Steve's involvement at BLYC continues today—as the club's I-LYA Delegate, consultant to the Race Committee, Club Historian, and webmaster.

At the encouragement of I-LYA P/C Dan van Heeckeren, Steve chaired the I-LYA Junior Bay Regatta in 2006 and, following that season, became the Chair of the I-LYA Junior Activities Committee—a position he held for 4 years. In every year since 2005, he has held an official position with the Junior Bay Regatta—Co-chair, Chair, Principal Race Officer, or Judge. He was eventually elected to the Board of Trustees, serving as President in 2011, and thereafter moved into the Chairs of I-LYA.

Professionally, Steve is a high school biology teacher at Millersport High School located on the west end of Buckeye Lake. Over the years, he has also worked with youth through the Boy Scouts, DeMolay, as high school Quiz Team coach, drama club moderator, and percussion instructor. Continuing a love for music that goes back to childhood, he can be found playing percussion for several local vocal and theater groups and at various establishments around Buckeye Lake with the Lakeside Trio.

Steve's dedication to young people led to Steve's involvement in I-LYA, beginning with junior sailing, and his dedication to that program in particular is quite evident. Although he never competed at Junior Bay himself, Steve firmly believes that there are few opportunities available to today's youth as unique and rewarding as the Junior Bay experience and he is proud to be involved each year. The past few years, Steve has also come to enjoy the Power and Sail Regattas and all that I-LYA has to offer our clubs and members. He is proud to serve this year as Commodore—the fourth from BLYC—and is looking forward to three wonderful regattas at the Bay.

# The Buckeye Lake Yacht Club

The history of the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club is inextricably linked to the waters whose name it bears. In the late 1800s, what was then known as the "Big Swamp" was dammed off to form the Licking Summit Reservoir on the Ohio-Erie Canal. As the canal days ended, the area was renamed "Buckeye Lake." But changing the name did not make it a lake. A shallow, murky reservoir, it was hardly fit for navigation. But, in 1906 an intrepid group of Columbus area businessmen met to form a Yacht Club there. At 8:30 a.m. on Memorial Day 1906, Columbus area yachtsmen arrived on the Interurban railroad and were ferried over to Orchard Island for the inaugural activities of the new upstart Club. The day featured racing for both power and sailboats along with a wide variety of social activities. Dues were \$4.00 per year with an initiation fee of \$2.00. Today they are, of course, much higher.

That winter, members of the new Buckeye Lake Yacht Club, now nearly 100 members strong, applied for membership in the Inter-Lake Yachting Association at the regular fall meeting in Toledo. While there was admiration for the new Club's spirit, I-LYA's long-standing rule had been not to admit any club not located on the Great Lakes. BLYC was, therefore, not eligible. But, I-LYA Commodore George Worthington (1896, 1905, 1908, & 1913) defended the upstart Club noting that Buckeye Lake was connected to Lake Erie via the Ohio-Erie Canal and was therefore eligible for membership. Thus, BLYC was admitted to I-LYA. The first inland club so honored.

In those early years there was much work to be done, not just in forming a new Club, but also in improvements to transform the old canal reservoir into a "real lake." The Club, with the assistance of then President of the State Board of Public Works, George Watkins, was an integral part of these efforts. Over the coming years, the Club would take a lease on a spot of "sometimes land" known as Sunken Island. The first Clubhouse, barely more than a boathouse, was constructed in 1907. It was replaced in 1913 with the current Victorian-style BLYC Clubhouse we know today. In those intervening years, improvements on both the island and the lake itself were many, transforming Buckeye Lake into what would later become known as the "Playground of Ohio," attracting visitors from all over to its amusement park and dance halls. In recognition of his efforts and assistance in this development, "Sunken Island" was renamed "Watkins Island" to honor George Watkins.


Over the years, BLYC has seen many improvements: the Clubhouse has been expanded and remodeled, the pool added, additional property and boat docks acquired, and more. BLYC's membership has included sailors and boaters from casual cruisers to club racers to National and World Champions. Throughout its history, BLYC has seen the many changes at our home lake—from the days of the big bands and the dance halls, to the rise and eventual fall of the amusement park—but BLYC has endured and continues to be a vibrant and successful club and active part of our lake community to this day.

One constant since her earliest days—Buckeye Lake Yacht Club has been active in I-LYA. BLYC members attended their first "Bay Week" in their first year of membership in 1907. In 1956, BLYC Junior Sailors won the inaugural I-LYA Junior Bay Week Regatta. Seven times, Junior Bay Week has been chaired by BLYC members, and numerous other members have been active over the years. Four of BLYC's members have gone on to serve I-LYA as its Commodore: Edgar T. Wolfe in 1937, Frank Miller in 1964, Gustav Schell in 1975, and this year, 2014, Commodore Steve Harris.





The object of the Club shall be the promotion of yachting and aquatic sports, cultivation of sociability among its members and the improvement of Buckeye Lake for boating purposes.





# Historically Speaking

By Tom Thanasiu, Jolly Roger Sailing Club

### I-LYA 125 years ago (1889):

George W. Gardner, I-LYA's founder and first commodore, still held the office. The regatta was held at Put-in-Bay.

### I-LYA 100 years ago (1914):

The commodore was Henry Hess of Toledo Yacht Club. A new Class T dory was introduced at the regatta held at Put-in-Bay, July 12–18.

### I-LYA 75 years ago (1939):

Elected commodore was Dr. A.R. Hackett of Detroit Yacht Club. The regatta, at Put-in-Bay, Aug. 6–9, was coupled with a United States Power Squadron rendezvous. The commodore's reception was held aboard the U.S. Coast Guard Cutter *Tahoma* and the commodore's dinner at the Bayview House. A Mardi Gras and street dance added to the festivities. I-LYA and USPS sponsored a Great Lakes Marine exposition at the Colonial Pavilion. Lyman Cats and Sea Gulls were added as new classes.

### I-LYA 50 years ago (1964):

Frank H. Miller of Put-in-Bay and Buckeye Lake Yacht Clubs was I-LYA's commodore. Jr. Bay was chaired by BLYC's Clifford S. Dum. Regatta dates were Aug. 2–5 at Put-in-Bay. I-LYA had 91 member clubs with over 28,000 members. A special attraction was an antique launch rally with Commodore Miller's *Dixie II* and *Unadilla* stealing the show. On the regatta's opening weekend 3,000 students invaded the island but rigid police control kept things in order. There were 187 entries in 26 classes.

### I-LYA 25 years ago (1989):

Rolf Krotseng of Edgewater Yacht Club was the 96<sup>th</sup> Commodore to serve I-LYA. The regatta started with Junior Sail July 23–28, Senior Sail July 28–August 2, and finished off with Power August 3–6.

Junior Sail was Chaired by Ed & Abbie Skoch of Put-in-Bay Yacht Club and co-chaired by Richard & Sue Duvall of Jolly Roger Sailing Club. Eighty-four junior racers representing 14 I-LYA clubs participated in Junior Race Week in 1989. The Cleveland Yachting Club Thistle team skippered by Matt Sessions and Laser sailor Brett Swasey advanced to the semi finals at Bayview Yacht Club, Detriot. Both won and advanced to compete in the finals at Indian Harbor Yacht Club in Greenwich, CT. where Sessions and crew finshed third sailing an Impulse 21, and in a Laser, Brett Swasey finished sixth.

Senior Sail had 29 classes and 252 sailboats on the lake racing this regtta. With the W. Wade Rapprich Memorial Trophy (presented to the MORC overall winner) to Mark Poulsen of Cleveland Yachting Club and the Parsons Memorial Trophy (presented to the winner of the largest class in I-LYA regatta, PHRF) to Jim Davis, *Orange Crate*, Bay View Yacht Club.

The Power Boat Regatta had 220 boats registered with 33 clubs in attendence. The yacht club with the highest attendance was Point Yacht Club with 38 boats. The newly dedicated first winner of the Commodore's Trophy was Dennis Mintus of Ashtabula Yacht Club.

### I-LYA 10 years ago (2004):

Richard McKee from Westlake Yacht Club was I-LYA's Commodore in 2004 and head of the 111<sup>th</sup> regatta. The Vice Commodore was Heidi Backus Riddle from Vermilion BC, with John Onacila from Beaver Creek Boat Club as Rear Commodore completing the Bridge.

The 49<sup>th</sup> Junior Race week ran July 18–23 with Rob & Abby Ruhlman as Chairmen and Doris & Dan van Heeckeren as co-chairs. There were 175 juniors racing representing 22 clubs. The top skippers of the week were Megan Riddle from Vermilion Boat Club in Thistle, Nick Thurber from North Cape Yacht Club in 420 and Ryan Lashaway, also from NCYC, in a Laser.

Powerboat Regatta began Monday July 26 with the docking and chicane contests. This year's Chairman was Tom Bernardi from South Shore Cruising Club and Vice Chair Rob Wolas from Swan Boat Club directing the Committees and volunteers. On the July 29<sup>th</sup> award presentation the Participation Trophy went to South Shore Cruising Club. Gary Coles from Sun Parlour Boat Club won the Commodore's Trophy. Power Regatta ended Friday July 30 to make room for Sail Regatta boats arriving from their deepwater feeder races to the Bay.

The Sail Regatta started on July 31. Don Bartels from Vermilion Boat Club was Chairman. The racing began on Monday morning August 2 and ended Wednesday the 4<sup>th</sup>. The Blue Gavel Trophy (PHRF Class Boat of the Year) went to *Gus* owned by Jim Bourgault from Grosse Ile Yacht Club. The Commodore Mike Smith Trophy (PHRF Class Overall) to *Revolution* owned by Jim Lengyl of Ashtabula Yacht Club. The Millennium Trophy (JAM Class overall) went to *Dragon Lady* owned by Brenda Woodruff also from GIYC.

This year's Yachtsmen of the Year award went to "Couple of the Year" Al & Marcia Ashley for their dedication and unselfish hours for the betterment of I-LYA.


- **I-LYA'S** basic purpose is the protection and promotion of the interests of boat owners and water sport fans in the enjoyment of their sport.
- **I-LYA** is a watchdog for proposed legislation that may affect yachting and yachtsmen.
- **I-LYA** serves as a clearinghouse for yachting information.
- **I-LYA'S** officers and committees are available to help its member clubs with boating related problems.
- **I-LYA** is the US Sailing Regional Sailing Authority and Appeals Body for race protests in the area.
- At the top level, **I-LYA** works hand and hand with US Sailing and class racing associations in developing fair and workable rules.
- **I-LYA'S** foundation, The Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund was established to support training, education, and junior activities. The Yachtsmen's Fund is a qualified 501(c)3 corporation and all donations are tax deductible.
- The annual Junior Regatta is one of the largest Junior Sailing Events in the United States and serves as a model for other clubs. The winners of "Junior Bay" receive scholarships from the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.
- **I-LYA** is also a leader in Junior Power boating in the area. The Junior Powerboat program which was developed in 2006, offers Leadership Training and navigational contests. The winners of this event are also awarded scholarships from the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.

- **I-LYA** consists of 147 member clubs and every member of each club is automatically a member of I-LYA, and is assured recognition among other clubs.
- **I-LYA'S** membership includes clubs from both the United States and Canada, making for strong international ties and competitions.
- Member clubs are represented by delegates to **I-LYA** and meet twice annually. Spring and fall meetings are held in the vicinity of the current Commodore. Class advisory, cruise and powerboat committees meet prior to the delegate's meeting, giving open forum for class improvement and rules enlightenment. Delegates elect the Flag Officers and Trustees at the Fall Meeting.
- **I-LYA** appoints delegates to US Sailing, Yacht Racing Union of the Great Lakes, and Western Lake Erie Cruising Association.
- **I-LYA** is governed by a nine member Board of Trustees. Business is conducted through the office of the Executive Secretary.
- **I-LYA** seeks corporate sponsorship to improve the services provided to its members and to control costs. Current sponsors include, BoatU.S., Mount Gay Rum, Put-in-Bay Yacht Club, TrueCourse Captain's School and West Marine.
- **I-LYA'S** Annual Regatta is held at Put-in-Bay, on South Bass Island, in western Lake Erie—the site of the historic Battle of Lake Erie in the War of 1812. It draws more than 500 Sail and Power boats annually.



# Final Voyage

Commodore Henry "Hank" Webber's life began just half a block from Lake Erie on December 20, 1936. He was born in Lorain, Ohio, the only child of Judge Henry P. and Hazel Webber. Growing up near the lake, he was destined to love the water.

Graduating from Lorain High School in 1955, Henry attended Kent State University determined to follow in his father's footsteps. On his first day of school at Kent State, his life changed forever for the better when he met Peggy—his wife to be of over 50 years. They married in 1960. He went on to graduate from Case Western Reserve University School of Law in 1962. Later that same year, the Webbers were blessed with the birth of their daughter Barbara, followed almost five years later by their second daughter, Linda. Not long after Linda was born, while watching boats cruise up and down the Vermilion River, Henry came up with the idea that the family should purchase a powerboat and start boating on Lake Erie. That began a succession of boats, the Webber's involvement in Vermilion Boat Club, and, eventually, I-LYA.


Hank served as an Assistant Prosecutor for Lorain County for several years prior to being elected Common Pleas Judge for the Domestic Relations division in 1971. During his 18 years as Judge, he was very interested in helping troubled youth and brought many improvements and new programs into the Juvenile Court. Henry was also active at the state and national levels addressing many of these same issues. As President of the State Child Support Committee, he lobbied for, and successfully obtained, unified child support guidelines in the state.

In 1970, the Webbers joined Vermilion Boat Club. Henry became active in VBC, serving on a number of committees and eventually serving as Commodore in 1980. VBC honored him as their "Outstanding Person of the Year" in 1988. Even as he became active in I-LYA Henry remained involved in VBC. Through the years, he remained active on a number of committees, most recently serving on the 100th Anniversary Committee in 2013. Hank was first introduced to I-LYA by P/C Art O'Hara at the 1970 Regatta at Put-in-Bay. As the delegate for VBC, he became increasingly active in I-LYA and served as our Commodore in 1991. Following his time as Commodore, he remained active within the organization. Among other involvements, he chaired the Admiralty Committee for many years. Each year, Henry has provided and presented the winner of the Art O'Hara Trophy for top Female Sportsman at Junior Bay Week with a locket. His loving wife Peggy plans to continue this tradition. Henry served as Fleet Chaplain in 2013 and, over the years, was a constant source of encouragement and advice for many upcoming officers of I-LYA.

Commodore Henry T. Webber passed on August 18, 2013 following a brief illness. His influence will be missed.

There is also a Team Trophy awarded each year to the top finishing club.

### Eligibility

Sailors must be at least 7 years old and can participate in the Traveler Series up to and including the summer immediately following their senior year of high school. (Please note that age requirements for Junior Bay are different.) The following fleets are eligible for the series: Optimists, Laser Radials, Laser Full Rigs, C420s, and Thistles. Minimum participation levels for series scoring are defined in the Notice of Series available online under Junior Sailing at I-LYA.org. Also there are the requirements for the Thistle Szambecki Award.

### Registration

Registration and scoring for the series and each qualifying regatta will utilize <u>noticeofrace.net</u>. Complete instructions are available on the Traveler Series page at <u>I-LYA.org</u>. Please read carefully as changes specific to junior sailing have been made.

### **State Youth Concussion Law Compliance**

I-LYA requires all clubs and coaches to comply with the appropriate youth concussion laws in the state where they are racing. Both Ohio and Michigan have online concussion training requirements. Please plan early to be in compliance. Complete details on the Traveler Series pages at I-LYA.org.

### I-LYA Junior Power Regatta at Put-in-Bay





These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

### General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

### **Charting and Course Plotting**

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

### **Navigation Competition**

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

### **Weather Contest**

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

### **On-the-Water** (Four contests using inflatables)

"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

**"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest** "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.

**Chicane** This a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in both forward and reverse gears without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.





**Docking** This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

### **Social Competitions**

In addtion to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

### **Geo-Quest**

New for 2014! Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

### **Cardboard Boat Race**

Who doesn't love making stuff with duct tape? Juniors combine their engineering skills with construction and boating knowlege. Entrants must be 12–17, pre-assembly is allowed, each boat to be designed for 1 or 2 people. Awards given to place finishers and a "Spirit award" given to the team showing greatest Team Spirit and "The Titanic Award" to the boat that sinks in spectacular fashion.

### **Fishing Derby**

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

### **Awards**

**Ribbons:** are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition.  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^d$  or  $3^d$  place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

**Junior Skipper Award and Trophy:** is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

**Scholarships:** 1st, 2d & 3d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.

#### **Power Contests**

#### Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events were selected by the committee, which are thought to provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) of these contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file in order to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and your name placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is kept in the Boaters' Museum at Put-in-Bay. The trophy is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy will be awarded to an individual competing in the various events. The trophy will NOT be awarded to a competing team. This is an individual award NOT a team award. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

#### **Predicted Log and Navigation**

Predicted Log & Navigation contest is a boat handling and navigation skill contest. Knowledge of your boat's performance along with piloting and navigational skills are a must. This is a two (2) part contest, with each contest being scored separately.

PART 1: Predicted Log A predetermined course established by the committee is designed around set "Control Points" (navigational aids, buoys, markers, landmarks) which must be passed or rounded, on either the port or starboard side. Calculating your "predicted Log" has been changed. New rules for a NO calculation predicted log have been approved by the committee. The contest will be run in or near the harbor allowing the use of an inflatable or other suitable small craft. The contestant will be required to maintain a constant speed and record the time at each mark. A two (2) man team is required; however, only the captain of the team will be eligible for any award (flag) or entry into the Commodore's Trophy competition.

**PART 2: Navigation Contest** This is a contest designed to test the piloting and navigation skills of each contestant. You will be required to have a chart of the Islands in Lake Erie, road map for South Bass Island, hand bearing compass, stop watch or other time device equipped with a second hand, and basic plotting tools. This contest will take you on a trip around South Bass Island and you will be required to take bearings on distant objects from various observation points around the Island. You will be required to establish a fix on your

position or the theoretical position of another mariner and demonstrate your understanding of chart reading and plotting a course. The mode of transportation will be your choice (car, golf cart, bike or on foot).

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is NOT intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete in this event, only one (1) flag will be awarded (to the team captain). Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

#### **Docking**

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

#### Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

#### Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 pm) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

#### Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

## **General Information**

- 1. The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- 3. The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- 6. Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's desk located at PIBYC.
