The 2018 cover is a combination of the flag commemorating I-LYA's 125th Regatta and a photograph taken during the 1926 I-LYA Regatta.

The 125th I-LYA Regatta flag came about due to an idea expressed by Put-in-Bay Chamber of Commerce businesses and the tenacity of Bryan Huntley. Designed by 2014 Commodore Steve Harris, this flag will fly on 35 light poles in DeRivera Park during the summer of 2018. Thanks to the over fifty 125th I-LYA Regatta Flag sponsors for their support!

The photograph was taken by photographer O. G. Herbster of Put-in-Bay during the 1926 I-LYA Regatta. The photo was made available by 1999 Monroe Boat Club Past Commodore Charles "Chuck" Wood II. His great-grandfather, G. Harley Wood, a Past Commodore of Monroe Yacht Club, competed in the Class "G" Cruisers, Power class of the Regatta, winning first place in his class. His boat, *FRANCES*, is the forward-most one of the two boats docked on the extreme right edge of the photo.



Meet the Commodore


Mike Powers, of Monroe, Michigan, is the Inter-Lake Yachting Association's 125th Commodore. His homeport is Monroe Boat Club, located at Bolles Harbor, Michigan. He previously served the I-LYA as Trustee in 2015 and as Powerboat Regatta Chair in 2016. Mike was honored by being named Mid-America Boating's Skipper of the Year in 2016.

Mike started in small sailboats with his father at Kiser Lake Sailing Club, north of Dayton, Ohio. He continued sailboat racing while attending the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, sailing a variety of boats ranging from 12-foot cat rigged dinghies to a 73-foot offshore racing ketch. Mike also sailed on the USCGC Eagle, a 295-foot barque, while at the Academy.

During his career with the U.S. Coast Guard, Mike served on three icebreakers on the Great Lakes, including the USCGC Mackinaw, Cheboygan, MI; the USCGC Mobile Bay, Sturgeon Bay, WI; and as Commanding Officer of USCGC Neah Bay, Cleveland, OH. His last shipboard tour was on USCGC Polar Sea, Seattle, WA. While aboard Polar Sea in 1994, the ship became the first United States surface ship to reach the North Pole and, in company with the CCGS Louis S. St. Laurent, they were the first surface ships to cross the Arctic Ocean. Mike worked in communications, information systems, and electronics support while ashore. He retired in 1998.

Following his Coast Guard career, Mike was an Electronics Engineering Technology instructor and Dean with ITT Technical Institute and an Assistant Professor and Electrical Engineering Technology Department Chair at Michigan Technological University, Houghton, MI. He retired from teaching in 2013.

Mike and his wife, Kathy, arrived in the Monroe area in December of 2006 and joined the Monroe Boat Club in January of 2008. He has served MBC as Power Fleet Captain, Financial Secretary, Rear Commodore, Vice Commodore, and Commodore in 2014. Mike and Kathy can often be found either sailing aboard their J/24, *Mariner*, or cruising around western Lake Erie aboard their boat, *Voyageur*.

The Monroe Boat Club (MBC) traces its roots to the formation of an independent boat club in 1868. The club brought fame to Monroe by finishing first place at the world-famous Henley Royal Regatta in Henley-on-Thames, England in 1878. Out of this club emerged the Monroe Yacht Club in 1902. In 1905 the Club first sponsored its now-famous annual muskrat dinner. Between 1905 and 1935 the Monroe Yacht Club grew to a membership of 500, and became a popular social spot and center of yachting activities on Western Lake Erie. The years between 1936 and 1945 were difficult economic times. There was a reduced interest in yachting and club activity.

Monroe Boat Club

The Club was revitalized by a merger of the Monroe Yacht Club and the Bolles Harbor Boat Club on Nov. 8, 1945. In 1948, club members volunteered their labor and used donated lumber from an old barn to build the docks and the clubhouse (1949).

During the '50s and '60s the club continued to expand. MBC Regattas were attended by 5000+ people. A grain-thrashing steam engine boiler was used to cook 600 dozen ears of corn and corn-on-the-cob was a special feature for many years. Over 90 sailboats in 13 classes raced during the annual regattas. 1966 saw the first Race for the Sisters which continues to this day.

The '60s and '70s included numerous improvements and expansions of buildings, grounds, and docks. The harbor was declared Bolles Harbor of Refuge with required dredging and seawall repair by the Waterways Commission. The banquet room was constructed for parties, dining, dancing, and rentals.

In 1972 the International Order of the Blue Gavel granted a charter to MBC. By the 1980s the Satin Gavel had become an integral part of Monroe Boat Club. To this day, many of MBC's Commodores and Auxiliary Presidents have held leadership roles in these international groups. The '80s and '90s saw growth, expansion of buildings, docks, and major renovation of the seawall.

MBC's famous Thursday Burger Nights are now in their fifteenth year. Our local community involvement has developed over time and now includes an annual Environmental Career Day for 7th graders from Monroe Middle School.

Monroe Boat Club recently purchased the property adjacent to the club, including two garages, two cottages, and additional dock and parking space. In 2017 the MBC Association (MBC-A) was formed as a non-profit corporation affiliated with Monroe Boat Club and approved as a 501(c)(3). Their purpose is "providing educational, social and recreational opportunities associated with fostering the development of a sustainable boating and clean water harbor community and providing programs and projects that build environmental and conservation stewardship in youth and adults."

The Monroe Boat Club stands on the shoulders of over 70 years of Monroe Boat Club history. With an active and involved membership and the good will shared, the club will certainly live up to and even surpass the vision our founding members had.



Tipper Niese is posthumously recognized as the 2018 I-LYA Regatta Chairman. Tipper and his family moved to Put-in-Bay in 1975 when he took over the Island General Store. In 1979 he bought the Colonial which was destroyed by a devastating fire in 1988. Tipper and his family bounced back from the disaster rebuilding what is now home of the Beer Barrel Saloon and Tippers Restaurant. Tipper became involved with the I-LYA in the 1980s while hosting the Junior Sailing Banquet at the Beer Barrel Saloon. He would close the establishment on a Thursday night for several hours to allow the competitors time for celebration and awards after a week of sailing. He soon was involved with all the I-LYA Regattas and became a strong supporter of the Senior Sail and Powerboat events. When I-LYA members purchased supplies from the Island General Store, meals in Tipper's Restaurant, or sought refuge at the bar in Tipper's Lounge, Tipper was always listening, providing suggestions, giving directions, and supporting I-LYA. Tipper's involvement led to many enhancements in our programs. If you wanted to know what Tip thought about I-LYA, you could look at the roof of the Beer Barrel Saloon where you would see the I-LYA Burgee proudly flying in the breeze.



Historically Speaking

I-LYA 125 Years Ago (1893)

The strength of I-LYA usually runs hand-in-hand with the economy of the USA. For the most part, early I-LYA and yachting in general was a Millionaires' Club. The average man was working to survive, not play on "some boat." If you pay attention to the last names of early members, it is a list of society's upper crust and wannabes trying to break through. The Panic of 1893 included the bankruptcy of railroads, bank runs and an economic crisis which took both rich and poor down with it. The 1st I-LYA was also a casualty and the 1893 regatta was canceled. Through the efforts of George W. Gardner-who founded Cleveland Yachting Club and who had served as I-LYA Commodore since 1885—I LYA was formally reorganized on March 19, 1894. With 9 clubs and an active and dedicated board of directors, an I-LYA regatta has been held every year since.

I-LYA 100 Years Ago (1918)



William R. Huntington of Sandusky Yacht Club was commodore of I-LYA's 23 clubs during 1918. He had previously held the post in 1901 and 1912. R. George Marsh of Grosse Point Yacht Club was vice commodore and Fred W. Wakefield of Vermilion Boat Club was rear commodore. W. J. Billingslea of Maumee River Yacht Club was secretary-treasurer.

The regatta started on Sunday,

July 14th with registration at the headquarters located on Fox's Dock, PIB. The flagship was Huntington's yacht *Thelma* which had served as Dr. Lee DeForest's radio transmitting vessel during 1907 when the world's first radio broadcast of a sporting event was made covering the I-LYA regatta at Put-in-Bay. It's interesting to note that, for the broadcast, *Thelma's* name was changed to *Electra*.

In addition to the traditional sail and power boat races, there were Naval Reserve maneuvers, Victory Hotel Band concerts, a hydroplane event, baseball, swimming and diving contests. An informal banquet and cabaret were held at the Hotel Crescent for \$1.50 a plate. Admission to the Ball was \$1 for the yachtsmen and free for escorted ladies. It was held in the Hotel Victory Ball Room and included the hotel's orchestra. On the last day, awards were presented at the Colonial and included trophies and cash prizes of \$25-\$75 for Power and \$15-\$40 for Sail. Due to the then ongoing war with Germany, the winners were encouraged to invest their prize money into War Saving Stamps. Third place for the sailors was a wristwatch presented by Commodore Huntington. The "other sports program," comprised of swimming, diving, dingey [sic], cat boat races and baseball, were awarded in cups, medals (gold/silver/bronze), cuff links, silver vanity boxes, and cameo bar pins—the latter 3 donated by The Merrill-Broer Co., Toledo, Ohio.

I-LYA 75 Years Ago (1943)



At the helm of I-LYA and its 46 clubs in 1943 was Cleveland insurance man Commodore "Before you die, burn, blow away or sink... See MILT!" Milton Gallup, N. Cleveland Yachting Club. I-LYA 1915 Commodore Harry Kendall of Detroit Yacht Club was secretary-treasurer and the future 1951 I-LYA Commodore Stanley W. Puddiford of Crescent Sail

Sports ashore included ball games, badminton, volley ball, and bowling at the Colonial. While the men raced, the ladies enjoyed bingo and tea. Sea Scouts were on hand to help with the regatta due to the number of men serving in the military in WWII. The Commodore's reception was held aboard the *P/F Mystic Isle.* A star was

added to a plaque on the Commodore's Memorial Monument with the passing of 1928 Commodore E. H. Reed, Toledo Yacht Club, on March 10.

I-LYA 50 Years Ago (1968)

Delegates from I-LYA's 95 member clubs met at Catawba Cliffs Beach Club on Dec. 18, 1967 to elect the new officers for 1968. Commodore Frank B. Stallings of Sandusky Yacht Club became a second term Commodore having served as Commodore Shephard's replacement the year before with his passing on July 9, 3 weeks before the 67th regatta.

The 13th Junior Race Week started Monday, July 29 and ran through Friday, August 2 with 20 Thistles competing for the quarterfinal for the Sears Cup and the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund Trophy and Award. The winners were David Daye (skipper), Mike Meany, Pam Spitz, and David Lonsdale (crew) from Edgewater Yacht Club. The Junior Race Chairman was Dean Palmer from Lake County Yacht Club.



The 75th sail regatta continued from August 3–8 with Wm. "Scotty" Robertson, Mentor Harbor Yacht Club, as Sail Chairman. Brisk winds prevailed for the 176 sailboats competing. Severe squalls delayed the final race start for two hours before the wind dropped and the race was slow.

The Flag Officers Reception was held at the historical island house, *Stonehenge*, and awards were held at PIBYC. According to the Chronology in the 1985 *I-LYA Yearbook*, the Cycle-Swim-Sail Guzzler's Trophy Race proved exciting!

I-LYA 25 Years Ago (1993)

Rolf R. Tinge of Point Yacht Club was Commodore of I-LYA's 128 clubs. Vice Commodore Harold Christenson of Sandusky Sailing Club and Rear Commodore Clay Mock of Mentor Harbor Yachting Club filled out the bridge.

The 38th Junior Race Week was July 25–30 with Kris & Reni Miller as chairpersons and 97 sail-

ors from 18 clubs participating. Three teams went on to the semifinals: Smythe—Justin Corbett, CYC; Bemis— James Lipp & Michael Kaim, MHYC (finished 8th in the finals); Sears— Aaron Strange, Nat Kolling, & Bob Foeller, JRSC. The Jolly Roger team placed 1st in the semifinals and went on to place 2^d in the finals in Texas after a close sail-off.



- **I-LYA** is the leader in Junior Sailing in the Midwest. The annual Junior Regatta is one of the largest Junior Sailing Events in the United States and serves as a model for other clubs. The winners of "Junior Bay" receive scholarships from the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.
- **I-LYA** is also a leader in Junior Power boating in the area. The Junior Powerboat program which was developed in 2006, offers Leadership Training and navigational contests. The winners of this event are also awarded scholarships from the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.

- **I-LYA** consists of 143 member clubs and every member of each club is automatically a member of I-LYA, and is assured recognition among other clubs.
- **I-LYA'S** membership includes clubs from both the United States and Canada, making for strong international ties and competitions.
- Member clubs are represented by delegates to **FLYA** and meet twice annually. Spring and fall meetings are held in the vicinity of the current Commodore. Class advisory, cruise and powerboat committees meet prior to the delegate's meeting, giving open forum for class improvement and rules enlightenment. Delegates elect the Flag Officers and Trustees at the Fall Meeting.

The Interlake Yachtsmen's Fund was incorporated on October 10, 1919. The initial goal of the organization was to generally build support and enthusiasm for the I-LYA and "to make the Association income sufficient to hold a good regatta each year and Every Year." Changes by the IRS in the 1980s eventually led to The Yachtsmen's Fund as we know it today. In 1986, the IRS qualifying letter renewed the charitable status of the Fund as a 501(c)3 organization whose mission is to raise money to be used for education and activities which would enhance the knowledge, safety, and enjoyment of sailing and power boating, primarily for youth. At this point, I-LYA took over the monetary relations with each Commodore's administration and the Yachtsmen's Fund began its transformation from an annual getting/spending group to an endowed charitable organization.


The Yachtsmen's Fund raises money and puts it to use by supporting activities for both sail and power, primarily for juniors, but also for individuals of all ages. These monies provide for education and coaching on and off the water, as well as for scholarships for those who excel at the I-LYA Junior Regattas. Championship Grants support youth who qualify to represent I-LYA at the National Championships and Challenge Team Grants encourage travel to regattas outside of the I-LYA region.

The Fund encourages and welcomes annual giving, life memberships, memorial donations and gifts in honor of special occasions. Our Dollarper-Member Club Program is essential to funding our annual activities and, going forward, we hope to have even more clubs pledging \$1 for each of their members.

The Yachtsmen's Fund is comprised of nine knowledgeable and dedicated trustees who oversee an invested endowment currently managed by Financial Engines and Charles Schwab. These investments ensure that we can meet scholarship obligations and fund our annual activities now and into the future.

2017 Chubb U.S. Junior Championships

The 2017 Chubb US Junior Championships were held in Tom's River, New Jersey from August 8–11. Nine I-LYA sailors competed in all three fleets after sweeping the Area E Championships held at Hoover Sailing Club in July. Three young men from Hoover Sailing Club and Cowan Lake Sailing Association, Ryan Squires, Luke Schumann, and Bryn Irvine, joined forces to compete for the Sears Cup which was held in Flying Scots. This year's single-handed sailors vying for the Smythe Trophy were Henrik Rolander from Cowan Lake Sailing Association and Joey Lark from North Cape Yacht Club. Qualifying in the C420 fleet and competing for the Bemis Trophy were Cameron Turner and Chase Stevenson from Chautauqua Lake Yacht Club and Ian Reimel and Meghan Dieball from Grosse Ile Yacht Club. All nine junior sailors took advantage of Championship Grants from the Yachtsmen's Fund to help with expenses.

At Tom's River, the sailors participated in a one-day pre-regatta clinic with expert coaching by US Sailing national coaches, including Kevin Burnham, 2004 Olympic gold medalist in the men's 470 class, and twotime US Olympian Amanda Clark. This informative clinic was followed by three days of close racing on Barnegat Bay. In the eleven boat Sears competi-

tion, the Area E team of Squires, Schumann and Irvine finished seventh. Area E's Henrik Rolander and Joey Lark finished 12th and 18th, respectively, in the 20 boat Laser Radial fleet. Competition for the Bemis Trophy was sailed in brand new 420 dinghies supplied by Zim Sailing. The Turner/Stevenson team finished 13th overall. In their thank you to the Yachtsmen's Fund, the Grosse Ile team of Reimel and Dieball acknowledged the tough competition and stated: "We gained a lot of valuable knowledge about sailing at this level challenging us to work harder and to learn even more."

Junior sailors from all 11 areas of US Sailing compete for limited spots at the Chubb Insurance sponsored U.S. Junior Championship. Competition to qualify is especially fierce in Area E as 101 sailors from Ohio, Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, and Ontario attended

the Area E Championship Regatta at Hoover Sailing Club, July 6–8, 2017. Challenging conditions all three days tested the competitors. 26 C420s, 22 Laser Radials and 8 Thistles made ours the largest combined qualifier in the country.

I-LYA is well represented on the US Sailing Junior Championship Committee with Jamie Jones from Hoover Sailing Club serving as the Area E representative and Dr. Matt Dubois from Grosse Ile Yacht Club serving as chairman. Because of their commitment and the relationship with US Sailing fostered by all who host Junior Olympics, Regional Symposiums, training programs, etc., I-LYA clubs are hosting three US Sailing Championships in 2018. North Cape Yacht Club will host the 2018 Chubb U.S. Junior Championship in August. Mentor Harbor Yachting Club hosts the U.S. Junior Women's Doublehanded Championship for the Ida Lewis Trophy in July and one of our newest members, The Foundry, in Cleveland is hosting the U.S. Team Racing Championship for the George R. Hinman Trophy in September.

Thank you to all the volunteers who make these events happen.

Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, hand held GPS and electronic chart instruction, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position using hand held GPS as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

On-the-Water (Four contests using inflatables)

"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings and identify your position using hand held GPS. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.

Chicane This is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in 2 directions without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.

Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

Social Competitions

In addition to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

Geo-Quest

Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

Cardboard Boat Race

Who *doesn't* love making stuff with duct tape? Juniors combine their engineering skills with construction and boating knowlege. Entrants must be 12–17, pre-assembly is allowed, each boat to be designed for 1 or 2 people. Awards given to place finishers and a "Spirit award" given to the team showing greatest Team Spirit and "The Titanic Award" to the boat that sinks in spectacular fashion. Bring your own cardboard and tape. NO materials will be provided by the committee.

Fishing Derby

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1^{st} , 2^{d} or 3^{d} place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2^d & 3^d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.

Power Contests

Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events were selected by the committee, which are thought to provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) of these contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file in order to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and your name placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is kept in the Boaters' Museum at Put-in-Bay. The trophy is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy will be awarded to an individual competing in the various events. The trophy will NOT be awarded to a competing team. This is an individual award NOT a team award. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

Predicted Log

The Predicted Log is a boat handling contest. A contestant's knowledge of their boat's performance and good navigation skills are necessary. A predetermined course is designed around a set of Control Points; which include buoys, markers, and landmarks, which must passed on the port or starboard side of the boat, as designated. A contestant's calculation of his/her Predicted Log requires the contestant to plot the designated course on his/her own chart and predict the elapsed time, in minutes and seconds, that he/she will pass each control point. Contestants must run the course at their chosen speed, higher than six knots; their prediction should be based on their chosen speed. The use of GPS is allowed when running the course. Contestants should know their boat's compass deviation, as most control points are not visible from the start of a leg. The Predicted Log committee will assign an impartial observer to accompany the contestant during the run. Each contestant is asked to bring at least one observer, who will be assigned to another contestant's boat. A short training class will held for observers before the start of the contest. Each contestant must furnish two watches able to read in hours, minutes and seconds. Greeley Trophy

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is not intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete, and if eligible, only one flag will awarded, to the team captain. Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 PM) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

Social Competitions

R: ANY CONTRACTOR OF A CONTRAC

Social competitions include the East vs. West Volleyball, the co-ed Softball Game, and senior Corn Hole. Volleyball takes place on the PIBYC grounds and the softball game, at the school. Because most of the participants play these games only once a year, the spectators usually get a good laugh from the week-end warriors but occasionally see some impressive athleticism. The rivalry is sometimes intense but always good-natured. A trophy is naturally awarded to the victors but bragging rights are the real "Gold Medal" that is sought. The cardboard boat races are also a source of "titanic" good fun.

General Information

- 1. The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- 3. The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- 6. Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- 7. Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's desk located at PIBYC.
