





Sandusky Sailing Club

The Aug. 4, 1932 birth of the Sandusky Sailing Club was the result of rebellion. The Roosevelt administration had just completed a WPA Project including the outer wall of Battery Park Marina and a sludge collection basin to the east for the water works plant. Threatened with an increase in dock fees at Sandusky's Battery Park Marina, a group of sailors organized a protest resulting in the formation of the Sandusky



With meager beginnings, the 44 members set out to form a club. They leased land from the city in a corner of Battery Park, consisting mainly of a large pile of rocks. The next year, they leveled the rock pile and constructed a small, but efficient, one-room clubhouse with volunteer labor and donated materials. That same year, a group of sailors began to discuss what could be done to promote a single one-design boat, common to all, in lieu of the several classes being raced. Unable to reach agreement, they hired Francis Sweisguth, designer of the Star, to draw up a design for a family boat, fast but with a simple rig, that would be both economical and easily home-built. The result was an 18' centerboard boat with a large cockpit and simple rig—the SC2 (Sandusky Sailing Club Class). Just a few years later, five of the new boats participated in the I-LYA Regatta. The club controlled the class until 1936, when a separate association was formed. Today, the boat is known as the "Interlake" and the sail insignia and SSC burgee are, for good reason, essentially identical. SSC has also had an impact in the growth of the Thistle class sailboat. First introduced at the 1945 I-LYA Regatta, the Thistle, a 17' open cockpit design, was notably faster than many other boats, including those much larger. In 1946, SSC was designated as Fleet #3 of the class with six boats on Sandusky Bay that year. By the '70s the fleet had grown to over 40.

In 1938, a galley and new club room were added and the original clubhouse became the "Commodores Room." That year also saw the formation of the Sandusky Junior Sailors—still an active program today.

Although some larger boats were sailing under the SSC burgee, organized offshore racing at SSC didn't begin until 1956 with the inauguration of what is now known as the Sandusky Islands Race.

In 1960, the city sought to redevelop Battery Park Marina, necessitating that SSC vacate the east corner of the property. Under the leadership of 1961 Commodore Jack Springer, the passion and commitment of SSC

sailors was exhibited. The club would vacate the marina by reversing the club entrance to face the sludge basin. In turn, the city allowed the club to develop the old basin, later designated by the city as the C. Webb Sadler Sailing Basin, for sailboats only. The seawall was opened to allow access to Sandusky Bay and the club entrance modified to face the new sailing basin. With a new marina, membership grew rapidly. Many families began to acquire larger racing/cruising boats and "out of towners" were attracted to the club where they could weekend on their boats. Soon thereafter, an offshore racing series began. With a greater variation in design and speed characteristics than in onedesigns, a "handicap system" was needed to equalize the boats. In the '60s, first racing under the MORC rule, followed by IOR, eventually PHRF was developed and is now the primary rating system at SSC and on Lake Erie. In the '80s and '90s, Tartan Tens and J/24s also began to race at SSC.

Finally negotiating a long-term lease in 1978, a new clubhouse was built and the original building razed. The new clubhouse features a handsome brick fire-place constructed with stone salvaged from the original "Commodores Room." Thus, heritage and tradition lives on. In 1992, a large, sheltered patio was added.

In 2012 SSC hosted the US Optimist Dinghy Assn. National Championship, and in 2013 won US Sailing's St. Petersburg Yacht Club Trophy for exceptional race management of the 2013 Thistle Nationals. SSC continues to host regional and national events each year.

Today, opening to the waters of Sandusky Bay with easy access to the Lake Erie Islands, Sandusky Sailing Club affords its members exceptional facilities unmatched in North America. SSC maintains very active Learn to Sail and Junior Racing programs, racing series and cruising activities for all sizes and types of yachts. The Club is blessed with an outstanding and dedicated race committee and a willingness to regularly sponsor national and international sailing events.



David Branson, a Melges 24 sailor from Toledo, Ohio was awarded U.S. Sailing's Arthur B. Hanson Rescue Medal at the April 2^d Inter-Lake Yachting Association Spring meeting in Westlake, Ohio.


On July 30, 2021, the annual I-LYA Bay Week Regatta was underway at Putin-Bay, South Bass Island, Ohio. Bay Week is a large regatta with multiple courses and fleets, including Melges 24s and the Formula Wave Catamaran National Championship.

Branson, skipper/owner of Melges 24 *Bullet*, and his crew were sailing out to the racecourse when their attention was called to a Formula Wave about 100 yards to their starboard. The skipper of that single-handed catamaran was slumped over his tiller and appeared to be in distress. Dave is a medical professional and sailed over to investigate. As they approached, they confirmed that the skipper was in medical distress.

Racing that morning had been postponed due to high winds, and at this time the wind was approximately 15 knots. The crew of *Bullet* quickly discussed the best course of action, and agreed that with his medical skills, Dave was the best person to provide assistance. They sailed alongside the catamaran which was sailing on its own downwind at about 7–8 knots. Dave jumped aboard. He performed an initial medical assessment of the victim and removed his lifejacket and moved him to the hard surface of a hull to be able to effectively perform CPR. Meanwhile, the crew on *Bullet* called for assistance both on the VHF radio and 911 on their cell phones.

A Race Committee boat responded to the distress call and came to tow the catamaran to shore. Dave had to steer the catamaran with his feet while continuing chest compressions as the boat was being towed. Rescue personnel met them ashore and performed a helicopter evacuation. Unfortunately, despite their combined efforts, the skipper of the catamaran did not survive.



Historically Speaking

I-LYA 125 years ago (1897)



Com. S.O. Richardson Jr.

1897, I-LYA's commodore, Solon O. Richardson Jr. of Toledo Yacht Club, was the perfect man for the job. After moving from Massachusetts to Toledo, Richardson honed his administrative skills as general manager, vice president, and later president of Libbey Glass Company in Toledo. Richarson learned to sail as a young man on Lake Quannapowitt, MA. After moving to Toledo, he

joined Toledo Yacht Club, eventually holding the office of commodore six times. He was also instrumental in the creation of the Mills Trophy Race.

With the squabbling over yacht ratings in the country, he was able to use his administrative and sailing experience to deftly represent the I-LYA in the creation of the North American Yacht Racing Union. At a meeting in New York's Fifth Avenue Hotel called by Commodore Richardson on May 1, 1897, 108 yacht clubs from the Pacific, Atlantic, and Gulf coasts, and the Great Lakes met to discuss the formation of the North American Yacht Racing Union (NAYRU), a national body for yachting that would adopt uniform racing and measurement rules. Richardson with his business skills practiced at Libbey and East Coast and upper-class contacts and with Ernest W. Radder of Cleveland YC represented I-LYA laying the groundwork NAYRU meeting. New York Yacht Club refused to send a delegate but did send an "observer." The Atlantic clubs didn't want to act too fast, and the Great Lakes yachtsmen didn't wish to be too pushy, so definite action was deferred until October 30, 1897. At the October meeting in New York, the North American Racing Union became a reality (with NYYC abstaining in the voting) and there came the promise of "a rule that will not promote the plankon-edge cutter, the fin keel, or the flat beamy and dangerous centerboard, but tend to build up a fleet of yachts safe, comfortable, and speedy and at a cost within the reach of the average yachtsman. Boats that were able to run from port to port without endangering the lives on board," reported Radder at the fall I-LYA meeting in November 1897.

The Regatta was held at Put-in-Bay, July 5–9 the earliest up to that time. The Commodore's Ball was held at the Hotel Victory with the stipulation that no alcohol was to be served. The Men's Smoker was at the Beebe House. Richardson's flagship was the racing sloop *Puritana*.

Racing was under the Seawanhaka Rules adopted three years earlier (NAYRU was ratified in that October). *Venenna* of Chicago won the 52 ft. class, *Sultana* of Toledo the 42 ft. Class and *Shamrock* of Cleveland won the 37 ft. Class. Naphtha launches raced for the first time. I-LYA's yearbook was not published that year to save money and a pocket-sized program was substituted. Detroit Yacht Club became I-LYA's 10th member.

I-LYA 100 years ago (1922)

The 1922 commodore was Charles W. Kotcher of Detroit Yacht Club., president of the C.W. Kotcher Lumber Co. The vice commodore was John W. Koehrman of Toledo Yacht Club with Harry D. Freeman of Buckeye Lake Yacht Club as rear commodore. William F. Meier of Cleveland Yacht Club who later founded Edgewater Yacht Club was the powerboat measurer. The flagship was Gar Wood's 110' yacht Frances, loaned for the occasion. Commodore Kotcher's

own boat was the *Betty-M*, holder of the world's record for express cruisers.

The regatta, I-LYA's 28th, was held at Put-in-Bay, July 17–21, 1922. All of the association's 27 member clubs were represented in the nine racing classes for sail yachts. It was the time of the fast, V-bottom runabout, the Hacker-Craft, Gar Wood and the custom-built jobs built by Christopher Smith, founder of Chris-Craft.

The attendance trophy was an expensive, bronze clock and barometer combination. Clubs vied for the trophy fiercely. Members shepherded passengers from the steamers *Put-in-Bay*, *Goodtime*, and *Greyhound* to the registrar's desk to sign up for their clubs. The winner was Cleveland Yacht Club.

There were 10 classes of powerboats racing, from hydros to large cruising yachts, plus one event for the "newfangled" outboard motors. The commodore's reception was



aboard the steamer *Arrow*. There were two concerts, the first over the newly discovered wonder: radio and the second by the Cleveland Yacht Club band in the flesh. Silent movies on boating followed both. Other entertainment included the ball at the Colonial Pavilion, a Monte Carlo party at the Hotel Crescent Pavilion, champi-

onship soft-ball games and swimming contests.

I-LYA 75 years ago (1947)

1947: at the helm was 62-year-old Commodore Edgar Weber "Cap" Kiefer, founder of the original Port Huron Yacht Club in 1923. He was the president of the Port Huron Paper Company and a leader in the community affairs. He was a yachtsman in the truest sense and held a master mariner license. He organized the Port Huron to Mackinac sailboat race in 1925 and sailed in the first three. 2

Vice Commodore was Alexander Winton Jr. of Cleveland Yachting Club and Theodore Farnsworth of Bayview Yacht Club as Rear. The 54th regatta at Put-in-Bay, August 3–7 was attended by 220 yachts in 24 classes. There was much grumbling about the food and lodging which was unexpectedly pricey. Many left before the regatta was over saying four days was more than they could afford. Because of the lack of hotel facilities in 1947, the town hall was opened to the younger sailors with accommodations for over 200.

Afterwards, Sandusky, Toledo and Detroit bid for the Regatta in 1948 but the persuasive invitation from Commodore James Poulos won out for Put-in-Bay.

Commodore Kiefer had refigured the NAYRU handicap tables and found many errors. The Vanderbilt Rules of yacht racing were adopted for trial use that year. People tore their hair out trying to interpret them. The real trouble with the rules was their utter simplicity—folks just

couldn't believe it. Miller's Boat Livery added the *West Shore* to its ferry fleet. *Blitzen* and *Thisbe* were the Detroit Deepwater race winners. *Hornpipe* and *Cotton Blossom* took the Cleveland Deepwater honors. The Toledo winners were *Irma Ann V* and *Monika*.

It was a light air regatta. Commodore Stan Puddiford was chairman of the race committee. Fred Brehob, Jr. of Erie won the junior sailing crown. *Armida* won in the 8-meters, *I-Wanna* in the Yankee Class. There was a gala reception at Detroit Yacht Club to honor Past Commodore Harry Kendall.

I-LYA 50 years ago (1972)



Com. George L. Sackett, MHYC

At the helm of I-LYA was another winning sailor, Dr. George Leslie Sackett Mentor Harbor from Yacht Club. He joined MHYC in 1938, becoming Commodore in 1962. He sailed a Canadiandesigned International-14, then a Thistle with his wife, Cora and son, George Ir. (I-LYA 1980) and James as crew. With his 36' Alden Coastwise Cruiser and Tartan 33, both named

Sesame, he sailed and won most of Lake Erie and Southern Ocean Racing Conference's important races. A radiologist by profession, he served in the US Army Medical Corps, active in the Pacific Theater of WW2 in the Philippines. After the war he helped set up the first American Hospital in Japan. He was past president of the Cleveland Academy of Medicine and was on the medical staff of Lake County Memorial Hospital and a member of the Cleveland Radiological Society.

The year started with the I-LYA Bowling Tournament January 19–30 at Hagerty Lanes in Toledo, Ohio with 42 teams. Bob Francis of ORYC was chairman. The top teams in 3 classes were "A" BLYC, "B" CCYC #5, "C" Lakeside Yacht Club #1. The star of the tournament was BLYC's Ed Williams, who had a 276 high game and a 712 series in Class "A."

On the weekend April 22–23, Peter Barrett lead the 1st Annual Jr. Sail Symposium with 104 young sailors. The first day was at Lakeland Community College with 4 hours of lectures covering aerodynamics, vectors, apparent wind and other theoretical and practical subjects, with a final session of racing rules. Afterwards was

a social get-together, picnic supper, movies and games to fill the evening. Sunday morning sessions began at 6:30 A.M. at MHYC with sailboats rigged on trailers to study sail settings at various Points of Sail. Cold, wet weather prevented actual sailing competition on the water and the morning sessions were completed by lectures in the clubhouse. Credit for organizing and helping I-LYA host this event was 1971 Jr. Bay (Sears) Champions Bill and Pete Frissell, Blair Hamilton and Todd Sackett, all MHYC. Also aiding, the Blue Gavel Club, South Shore Lake Erie, who posted financial support and staffed both day's sessions.

1972 was the beginning of the Lake Erie Offshore Racing Championship. Then it consisted of 7 challenging races, weighted in terms of length and difficulty, with certain alternates as indicated, 4 classes—champions of each classes high point accumulated. The overall highest total points for the series, regardless of class, earned Boat of the Year. The highest race percentage was the Lake Erie Race, July, 8,240 mi. (600 total points per class, 24 points per position). Next was the Mills Trophy Race, 75 mi. (300 tppc, 12 ppp) and I-LYA's Regatta, 45 mi. (3 races, 300 tppc, 12 ppp). Other races were Roberts Trophy Race, Lyman Trophy Race, and the Indigo Memorial Trophy Race. Over 100 boats sailed in some, if not all, of the races, representing clubs from Buffalo to North Cape, and some Detroit clubs as well. Participation and keen competition were the objectives of the series and the first year's results seemed to bode well for the future. The winner was Cheetah II, C. Richard Newpher, MHYC with 1512 points; 2^d Stratagem III, J.D. Harnett, MHYC with 1496 points.

I-LYA Regatta, August 5–9, began on Saturday with the Powerboat Predicted Log Contest. Jim Leisec of St. Clair Yacht Club winning the Greeley Trophy. Deepwater feeder races were from Cleveland, Vermilion, Toledo, Port Clinton and Sandusky. Sunday was the Detroit

Deepwater and a tune-up race at PIBYC. A concert by the Lochaber Pipe Band of Lorain preceded the Memorial Service. The weekday racing results netted the Captain Louis G. Northrup Memorial Trophy Class R championship for Bill Gordon CYC; Lyndon Babcock Crescent Sloop Class Trophy went to James H. Powell, CSYC; Boston Thistle Trophy to

Neal Thurber, NCYC; K Cat Ghost Trophy to Joan Booker, PIBYC; and the Parsons Trophy (class with the greatest number of boats) to Art Barrie, JRSC.

Weekday on-shore activities were Flag Officer's Reception for all registered yachtsmen and crews and guests at Borman's Cottage, Commodore's Dinner at the Boathouse, Ladies Party at the home of Commodore Biedler on Peach Point and the Sailor's Beer Bust at the rear of PIBYC.

I-LYA 25 years ago (1997)



Com. Frederick B. Weiss, WYC

The commodore was Frederick Byers Weiss, Wildwood Yacht Club, a member since 1979 and worked many positions, twice as commodore. Fred was also active with Greater Cleveland Boating Association being WWYC's delegate from 1987–1997. From childhood, Fred had a love affair with the water and boats, owning three sail

and two power. Years of service to I-LYA started with the dock committee and continued into K-Cruise creator, chairman and director, editor and ad salesman for the I-LYA yearbook, and working the finish line at the regattas. No one is this busy without a lot of help and in 1993 Fred and his wife Nancy were I-LYA Couple of the Year. Fred was trustee three years then worked his way through the chairs to become commodore. He devoted much of his life to the education of others. Fred taught for seventeen years at McKim Technical institute, climbing to position of chief instructor. For 11 years (up to 1997) with Akron Public Schools in the career education department teaching junior and senior level Electronics at East High School. Besides teaching, he worked part-time TV repair at his business in Ravenna, Ohio. He was a broadcast engineer and part time DJ at WSLR Akron and a salesman at LaSalle Yacht Sales in Westlake. As if they were not busy enough, Nancy and Fred had seven children to raise.

The 1997 K-Cruise began with the rendezvous place of Bay Point Yacht Club Saturday, July 5 with the lake still sloppy from the 4th of July storm, but the 8 boats prevailed for lunch and a viewing of the postponed Cedar Point fireworks. Sunday was a good crossing of Lake Erie to Elba Mar Boat Club just inside the Detroit River on Grosse Ile followed by a barbecue rib roast. Monday


was up the Detroit River, through Lake St. Clair to the St. Clair River to Chanel Escarte and on to Wallaceburg, Ontario. Tuesday was heavy rain, but it didn't dampen the 19 boaters' spirits (or cocktail party and pizza bash). Wednesday was back to Lake St. Clair and down to Detroit Yacht Club for dinner and overnight. Thursday was a short ride across the river to Lakeview Marina in Windsor, Ontario for gambling. Friday returned to Lake Erie to Swan Boat Club and an invite to a cook-it-yourself steak and chicken cookout. Saturday morning was across the lake to Sandusky Bay/Harbor Bay Yacht Club in time to participate in the new flag pole dedication ceremony. Harbor Bay was I-LYA's newest member and each captain was presented with a bottle of Firemen's Champagne autographed in gold lettering by the wine master. The last evening was spent at Margaritaville for dinner and cocktails. Sunday was back to reality and home ports.

The 42^d I-LYA Jr. Race Week was chaired by Ed and Abby Skoch. 105 sailors, from 15 clubs, began Sunday July 20 with the normal check in, boat set up and inspection, meetings, Ice Breaker dinner at PIBYC and participants' photo at Perry's Memorial. The fleet was split into Championship and Commodore Series after 2 days of racing. The top Championship winners were in Thistles: Ryan Anstrom, Scott Bailey, and Kevin McLaughlin, (Pymatuning Yacht Club); JY-15s: Ian McCreery, Erin Shea (Hoover Yacht Club); and Lasers full rig: Kristen Zillmann (Edgewater Yacht Club).

The I-LYA 104th Sail Regatta with Bryan Huntley as Chairman, began Saturday August 2 with most of the deep water finishes—Detroit's finishing Sunday. The racing rates for Deepwaters were \$40 for all except \$25 Sandusky Steeplechase. The Regatta Series rates were:



Five years later in 1968, they married. They had two children and many grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Together, Fred and Char enjoyed 4-wheeling through the years. He loved boating and was also an avid hunter.

Fred worked for Ford Motor Company, which took him from Cleveland to Detroit, and eventually to his residence in Lambertville, MI. He retired from Maumee Stamping in 2007 with more than 37 years under his belt.

While employed by Ford, Fred was frequently invited to go fishing with the guys. This didn't always sit well with Charlene because she wanted in on the action too! So, with some encouragement from cousins, Fred and Char bought their first boat in 1983—a little 20' vessel named *Fan-ta-Sea*. From that point on, not only did they catch a whole lot of fish, but they caught the boating bug as well. It wasn't long before they became members of Cooley Canal Yacht Club, and before you could say, "There's a sucker born every minute," Fred found himself moving through the chairs to become 1993 CCYC commodore. Fred wore many hats for the boating community, including District 9 Blue Gavel President in 2001, I-LYA registrar 2002 to 2005, and I-LYA Trustee 2005 to 2008.

You know what they say: The two happiest days in a boater's life are the day they buy their boat and the day they sell their boat. Fred and Char sold their last boat in 2005. However, they both remained active in the boating community. In 2009 Fred moved through the chairs of I-LYA leadership and was thrilled and honored to be the 2011 I-LYA commodore.

Sadly, we lost Fred November 12, 2021 and then Charlene June 14, 2022. The boating community is grateful for both of their contributions to the betterment of the sport.



- **I-LYA** is also a leader in Junior Power boating in the area. The Junior Powerboat program which was developed in 2006, offers Leadership Training and navigational contests. The winners of this event are also awarded scholarships from the Inter-Lake Yachtsmen's Fund.

- **I-LYA** consists of 140 member clubs and every member of each club is automatically a member of I-LYA, and is assured recognition among other clubs.
- **I-LYA'S** membership includes clubs from both the United States and Canada, making for strong international ties and competitions.
- Member clubs are represented by delegates to **I-LYA** and meet twice annually. Spring and fall meetings are held in the vicinity of the current Commodore. Class advisory, cruise and powerboat committees meet prior to the delegate's meeting, giving open forum for class improvement and rules enlightenment. Delegates elect the Flag Officers and Trustees at the Fall Meeting.


Mid America Boating Skipper of the Year

Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, hand held GPS and electronic chart instruction, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position using hand held GPS as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.

On-the-Water (Four contests using inflatables)

"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings and identify your position using hand held GPS. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.





Chicane This is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in 2 directions without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.

Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

Social Competitions

In addition to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

Geo-Quest

Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

Fishing Derby

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1st, 2^d or 3^d place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2d & 3d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.



Power ContestsCommodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events have been selected by the committee which provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and the winner's name will be placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy is an individual award and will be awarded to an *individual* competing in the various events NOT to a competing team. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

Predicted Log

The Predicted Log is a boat handling contest. A contestant's knowledge of their boat's performance and good navigation skills are necessary. A predetermined course is designed around a set of control points; which include buoys, markers, and landmarks, which must be passed on the port or starboard side of the boat, as designated. A contestant's calculation of his/her predicted log requires the contestant to plot the designated course on his/her own chart and predict the elapsed time, in minutes and seconds, that he/she will pass each control point. Contestants must run the course at their chosen speed, higher than six knots; their prediction should be based on their chosen speed. The use of GPS is allowed when running the course. However the use of auto-pilot during the contest is strictly prohibited. Contestants should know their boat's compass deviation, as most control points are not visible from the start of a leg. The Predicted Log committee will assign an impartial observer to accompany the contestant during the run. Each contestant is asked to bring at least one observer, who will be assigned to another contestant's boat. A short training class will be held for observers before the start of the contest. Each contestant must furnish two watches able to read in hours, minutes and seconds.

Start Buoy R "2" FI R 4s, PIB Harbor Entrance Leave to Port Steer a course of 250 degrees T for 2.60 NM (2.99 SM). At that point, give timepiece to the observer and proceed to:

Control Pt. 1 Buoy RN "2" (West of North Bass Island)
Control Pt. 2 Buoy R "6" FI R 4s, Bell
Control Pt. 3 Buoy RN "4"
Leave to Starboard
Leave to Port
Control Pt. 4 Buoy G "1" FI G 4s, Bell
Steer a course of 235 degrees M until Ballast Island Light disappears, then

Steer a course of 235 degrees M until Ballast Island Light disappears, then proceed to:

Finish Buoy R "2" Fl R 4s, PIB Harbor Entrance Leave to Port *Committee Distance 17 NM*

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is not intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete, and if eligible, only one flag will awarded to the team captain. Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 pm) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

Social Competitions

Social competitions include the East vs. West Volleyball, the co-ed Softball Game, and senior Corn Hole. Volleyball takes place on the PIBYC grounds and the softball game, at the school. Because most of the participants play these games only once a year, the spectators usually get a good laugh from the weekend warriors but occasionally see some impressive athleticism. The rivalry is sometimes intense but always good-natured. A trophy is naturally awarded to the victors but bragging rights are the real "Gold Medal" that is sought.

General Information

- 1. The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.
- Refer to the official Regatta schedule and information available at the registrar's deck for the specific place and time of each contest.
- 8. Entry forms for all contests are available at the Registrar's desk located at PIBYC.

One person participating in one event equals one participation point. The club earning the most participation points earns the 1st place Participation Flag. 2d and 3d place flags are also awarded.


