

Meet the Commodore

Our 2021 Commodore, "Captain Bob" Lang, as he is known to the boating community, has been a lifelong boater on the Great Lakes. He has been married to his high school sweetheart, Bobbi, for 54 years and as newlyweds they spent their first year of marriage aboard Bob's parents' boat, a 38' Chris Craft. Bob and Bobbi have owned many boats over the years, both sail and power, and currently have a 50' Hatteras Convertible named *Transition*. The name celebrates the sale of their business and segue to retirement. They plan to travel the lakes and visit I-LYA member clubs aboard *Transition* in 2021. Captain Bob first began boating as a youngster aboard his parents' boats back in the 50s. Bob's love of boats and boating led him to open a marine store in the late 60s



Bob's involvement with the I-LYA dates back to the early 80s, going to the Powerboat Regatta and participating in the boating competitions. In fact, Bob and Bobbi have attended almost every Power Regatta and Spring and Fall Meeting since 1981. Some of Bob's achievements over the years include being the 1984 commodore of his home club, West River Yacht and Cruising Club (WRYCC) and serving as I-LYA trustee in 2012, 2013 and again in 2017. Bob's love of the Powerboat Regatta got him involved in chairing many of the events including canoe races, inflatable races, and the cardboard boat races. In 2009, Commodore Ed Payne asked Bob to take over the Junior Powerboat Regatta. This program has come a long way in the past 11 years and Bob continues to develop new and interesting contests for junior powerboaters. Bob believes that the future of I-LYA lies with our youth and is committed to seeing the Junior Power Regatta grow and prosper. In 2010, he served as treasurer for the Powerboat Regatta and four years later was chairman of the event. Bob received the Mid America Boating Skipper of the Year award in 2013 and in 2016 was named I-LYA's Yachtsman of the Year. Bob and Bobbi are both life members of the Yachtsmen's Fund.

Before retiring, Bob was the owner of a steel fabrication shop and engineering company specializing in structures. He enjoyed many years in the industry, especially the military contracts with the US Navy. In 2019, Bob sold the business and now enjoys woodworking. When he is not out on the boat, you will find him in his woodshop, "The Old Garage," working on a nautically themed project. The past 40 years of involvement in I-LYA have provided Bob with some great memories, but more importantly, he has made lasting friendships. His knowledge of boating, his experience, and his leadership will provide the necessary tools to uphold the goals and traditions of the I-LYA and continue to move it in a positive direction.

West River Yacht and Cruising Club

In 1965, West River Yacht and Cruising Club was formed as West River Yacht and Country Club on Grosse lle. The organization operated a nine-hole golf course and marina facility built on the former Knudsen summer residence, located on West River Road across from Detroit Edison on the Trenton Channel.


In 1970, application to join the Inter-Lake Yachting Association (I-LYA) was made and West River received interim membership with full membership status finally granted in 1973. This was an exciting time for West River, and they immediately became involved in the powerboat activities within I-LYA. 1975 marked the first official Powerboat Regatta and West River's PC Raymond Sprow was instrumental in organizing the Detroit area clubs' participation at this inaugural event held at Presque Isle Harbor, Erie, Pennsylvania. West River's love for the Power Regatta remains strong today. The mid 70s, however, also brought disruption to the club when a disagreement between responsible parties resulted in the loss of their facility when Grosse lle Township took over management of the property and opened Waters Edge Country Club.

WRYCC entered a period of struggle and challenge. Thankfully, several of our long-term members kept hopes high and expectations reasonable. Although no longer officially connected with the township property, WRYCC continued to function as a viable yacht club, holding monthly meetings at various locations in the downriver area. Our membership within I-LYA remained intact due in large part to the efforts of lifetime members Paul Migda, PC Bob Lang, PC Bob Campbell and PC Dick Kott, to mention a few. The name was changed to West River Yacht and Cruising Club to better reflect the club's central purpose.

In 2001, West River was presented with the opportunity of returning to its roots, and in 2002 Grosse Ile Township named WRYCC the official yacht club for the facility known as Water's Edge Municipal Marina. In 2003, West River was granted full membership into the Associated Yacht Clubs.

In 2020, West River officially designated Smokies on the Water (the restaurant at Water's Edge) our home. Over the years, West River has continued to demonstrate its resilience and ability to adapt to the ever-changing dynamics of our boating community. One constant, however, is that our members always enjoy the many social functions and boating activities planned each year and look forward to the annual I-LYA Regatta.





Scott is a member of Bay View Yacht Club and served as their commodore in 1997. He first started coming to the Powerboat Regatta in 1994 and since that time has not only competed in the various competitions but has volunteered to chair adult putt-putt and the predicted log contest. He has taken a serious interest in our Junior Powerboat Program and you will find the Kneisel juniors, Josh and Erin, named as first place winners in many of the contests. Both Josh and Erin have now aged out of the Junior Powerboat Program, but Scott continues to volunteer his time and the family tender to allow other juniors to take part in the contests. Scott is BVYC's delegate to I-LYA and enthusiastically promotes the Powerboat Regatta to his club members and fellow boaters. Historically Speaking

I-LYA 125 Years Ago (1896)



The Canada's Cup

1896 was the year of the first Canada's Cup race. Vencedor of Chicago and Canada of Toronto were due to battle for the sterling compotier donated by Commodore S.O. Richardson of Toledo for the week after the I-LYA regatta. The contest attracted large fleets of yachts from Lakes Michigan and Ontario. The Canadians won most of the prizes, which were cash in those days.

Canadian-born George H. Worthington learned to sail in Toronto Bay. He moved to the United States at the age of 17. He wore many hats: wholesale grocer, railroad contractor, sandstone quarrier, industrialist, banker and world renowned stamp collector with a reputation of accomplishing anything he set his mind to. He became commodore of Cleveland Yachting club in 1895 and held that position until 1914, overseeing construction of the new CYC clubhouse that his predecesor Commodore Gardner began. Worthington became commodore of I-LYA at the age of 46, a position he would hold three more times (1905, 1908 & 1913). Vice commodore was C.J. Lichtenburg of Detroit Yacht Club, Rear commodore was

Henry Tracy of Toledo Yacht Club. This year's regatta was held at Put-in-Bay August 18–21. Worthington's flagship was the steel schooner yacht *Priscilla*, built originally for the America's Cup defense.

Classes competing in the sailing events were the 50, 46, 40, 35, 30 and 25-footers. There was one scheduled event for naphta launches and the squadron sail for the steam yachts. The Canadian schooner, *Zelma*, in the 46-foot class, won the free-for-all for the Hotel Victory Cup.

The regatta produced a great boom in yachting, especially at Toledo, Cleveland and Sandusky. George F. Anderson of Sandusky went to Toronto and purchased the fast cutter *Eva*. Captain Herman Krause of Cleveland Yachting Club built the famed sloop *Vinco*. There was much grumbling about the lack of uniform racing and measurement rules. I-LYA set the groundwork for a meeting in New York to organize the North American Yacht Racing Union. East coast yachtsmen resisted the movement.

I-LYA 100 Years Ago (1921)

In 1921 F.W. Roberts, 1915 PC of Cleveland Yachting Club, was our commodore. Roberts was the president of Cleveland's F.W. Roberts and Co. (est 1881), an office supply company selling everthing an office could need from furniture to pen to paper. The vice commodore was George H. Wood of Monroe Yacht Club with E.H. Scott of Erie Yacht Club as rear commodore. There were daily power boat races at the regatta held at Put-in-Bay, July 10–17, run under the International Power Boat Union rules. The regatta flagship was Roberts' 50' auxiliary wooden sailing ketch *Petrel*, built in 1906 in Detroit by J.H. House. Sailing classes included A, J, Taft Cup, Cats, Club Cats, R, Star, and yawl. The Taft Cup was donated to the Toledo Yacht Club by President Taft for the new (and only at the time)

1-design class, 22' K Cats. The yachtsmen's dinner was held at Hotel Crescent and the commodore's reception at Hotel Commodore. PIBYC Com. A.G. Smith's Oak Point lawn accommodated the ladies' bridge party. There were shore sports, dinghy races, ball games and prohibition.

The squadron sail was on Thursday as was the formal yachtsmen's ball at the

Colonial Pavilion. Admission was \$1 per couple. Prizes were distributed on Friday at Hotel Crescent. It was the year when the marconi rig began to replace the gaff for racing sail yachts. The Yacht Racing Union of the Great Lakes rules called for remeasurement of all boats that switched to the new rig. Prizes were cash and cups.



1946 Com. Lester R. Mylander

I-LYA 75 Years Ago (1946)

Doctor of Osteopathy, WWI veteran in the overseas US Medical Service, and founder of the Sandusky Memorial Hospital (1933), Lester R. Mylander of Sandusky Yacht Club was our 1946 commodore. Edgar W. Kiefer of Port Huron Yacht Club was vice commodore and Alexander Winton Jr.,

of Cleveland Yachting Club, rear commodore. It was the first post-war year. Fuel rationing was ended and the first new postwar boats were being delivered.

Among new classes of sailing craft were the Great Lakes-21s—later renamed the International-21s—the Thistles and the Yankees. The spring and fall meetings were held at Sandusky Yacht Club. Regatta dates were August 11–15 at Put-in-Bay.

Fred Temple's *Thisbe* and Ed Wunsch's *Shamrock* tied for first place in the 8-meter Class. Don Asher's *Roamer* from CYC won in the Star Class, Charles A. Buysee's *Last Straw* of DYC in the cruising class, Jack Briner's *Host* from Bayview Yacht Club in the C Class and L. Carnegie of DBC in CKs. Commodore Alexander Winton Jr. made

a clean sweep with *Puffin* in the R Class, winning the final race in a four-way photo finish.

Squalls and heavy weather at the regatta's start kept many contestants away. Still there were 179 entries from I-LYA's 54 member clubs. The regatta was almost cut short by the grumbling of the sailors about the poor food and accomodations at high prices at the Bay. There



was growing sentiment to shift the regatta to Sandusky Bay. The commodore's ball, shelved for the duration, was revived and held at the Colonial.

I-LYA 50 Years Ago (1971)

The 1971 commodore was Arthur N. O'Hara of Vermilion Boat Club (PC 1965). Commodore O'Hara worked for the Thew Shovel Co. in purchasing. He worked his way up the I-LYA ladder by chairing multiple committees such as Entertainment, Junior Trophies, and Patrol Facility. He may have been the first to organize an I-LYA vacation with an 8-day/7-night stay in Acapulco that fall.

The Junior Championship chair was Cal Canfield IV from VBC. Bill Frissell (skipper) and Blair Hamilton, Tod Sackett and Peter Frissell (crew) of Mentor Harbor Yacht Club beat 19 other Thistles, winning and qualifying to compete in the Sears Cup finals. The Sail Regatta, August 8–11, was noted for its one-of-a-kind series for cruising, multi-hull and centerboard classes. It attracted 200 sail yachts with 124 in the cruising classes.

Bob Bairas of Edgewater Yacht Club sailed *Odyssey* to a clean sweep in MORC-A as did Dan Barnard of Chagrin Lagoons Yacht Club with *Ponytail* in MORC-C. Jack Ruelbach of Northeast Yacht Club trounced the Wayfare Fleet. Bob McGee of VBC swept the Ensign series with *Kelley*. Art Shomer's *Pop-N-Jack* of CYC was the R Class champ. It was one of I-LYA's finest regattas with William P. Connelly of Grosse Pointe Yacht Club running the races.

At year's end. Dr. George L. Sackett, Sr., of Mentor Harbor Yachting Club was elected to succeed Commodore O'Hara as I-LYA's 72^d commodore.

I-LYA 25 Years Ago (1996)

At the helm of I-LYA in 1996 was Michael Ashbrook Smith who was born in Cincinnati, Ohio but spent his summers at the family cottage on Catawba Island. His time was spent boating in the area waters in a variety of boats, including a sailing outrigger canoe, a small power runabout and a sailing pram made of lumber from the family business in Findlay, Ohio. A Rebel was purchased to be sailed at "the Bay." After high school, Mike worked in the steel business and graduated from the University of Cincinnati in 1965. He eventually became a private search analyst and owned his own business. Mike owned many boats over the years but the flagship at the Bay was a 32 foot powerboat MIJO. When sailing he usually crewed on his dock partner's 35 Express, TIME. The most recent I-LYA PHRF Trophy, the Mike Smith Trophy, is a mounted ship's clock. Over the years, Mike held membership in a number of clubs, sailing with Port Clinton Yacht Club first then Huron Yacht Club in the mid 70s eventually becoming

their I-LYA delegate. Mike was busy in 1991. He was I-LYA Powerboat chair, I-LYA trustee, president IOBG District 7 and Henry Webber's I-LYA fleet captain working all 3 regattas. In 1994 Mike joined

Sandusky Yacht Club, was elected to I-LYA rear commodore and resigned his trustee position.

I-LYA's 1996 K Cruise out started at Fairport Harbor Yacht Club on July 6th with 11 boats and a cookout put on by Chuck and Marilyn Fullmer. The next day took them to Ashtabula Yacht Club for an overnight and then continued to Erie Yacht Club for a two-day layover. The skies were clear but there was a strong North wind and rough seas. Departure was delayed several hours in hope that the wind would die down. Six boats left at 11 A.M. and the second group departed at 2:00 P.M. for Port Bruce, Ontario to dock at North Erie Yacht Club. The last port of call was Kanagio Yacht Club in Port Stanley, Ontario. With a still strong north wind, the ride was fairly smooth as they stayed close to the lee Canadian shoreline.

In Port Stanley, the cruisers took the train to St. Thomas about 30 miles north inland Friday morning of July 12th. When the eleven o'clock bridge opened on Saturday and once outside the protection of the Canadian shoreline, they encountered scattered showers and high seas. The K Cruise armada rode these waves for four hours and it wasn't until they saw the Cleveland skyline that the lake started to settle down and it was there that they said their goodbyes and went to their home ports.

The 41st I-LYA Jr. Race Week with Arne and Marge Hanson, JRSC, as chairpersons for the regatta started with 102 participants from 13 clubs. Sunday July 21 was busy and included registration, inspection and launch, check-in at the Islander Hotel, race clinic sponsored by US Sailing, ice breaker dinner, team photos at the monument and finally, lights out. The ice breaker for the adults was held at the Tigges' home. Racing was Monday morning through Thursday afternoon on Thistles, Flying Juniors and full rig lasers in 2 classes: the Championship Series and the Commodore Series. The top winners in Thistle were Vermilion Boat Club's Matt Moehe, Dave Lopez and Sarah Potter; Flying Juniors Ian McCurry and Erin Shea (HYC); Lasers Kristin Zillman (EYC). Ray Greene Trophy/individual sportsman went to Cleveland Yachting Club's Patrick Poehman and the Art O'Hara Trophy/ individual sportswoman went to Rachel Arth of the Putin-Bay Yacht Club.

Saturday morning the 23^d was the finish of the Cleveland Deepwater with Toledo, Sandusky and Port Clinton races finishing in the evening. Sunday afternoon the Detroit Deepwater boats finished.

I-LYA Regatta races were Monday, July 25th through Wednesday with Don Bartels, LYC and Brian Huntley, SSC co-chairing. 21 classes raced with the following top winners: PHRF class overall, winner of the Mike Smith trophy, Scott Boettner, FYC; MORC Championship trophy, *Splashdance*, Lazlo Goda, NCYC. The Multihull Class was part of the US Sailing Alter Cup Semifinal Championship with James Diamond on *Cheap Date II* winning.


There was a break in the action until the Jr. and Senior Powerboat Regattas started on Thursday, August 8 and ran through the 10th with the docks needing to be cleared by Sunday the 11th. Rich McKee of Westlake Yacht Club chaired. Total boats registered was 182 with the greatest participation from South Shore Cruising Club. The Greeley Predicted Log Trophy went to Dennis Mintus, AYC. The Snodgrass Committee's trophy for overall went to Roger Viculus, FYC, who also won the I-LYA predicted log contest. GCBA beat AYC in Softball and the Junior Navigation contest went to Greg Sattler, WWCC.

I-LYA 10 Years Ago (2011)

Our 2011 Commodore was Fred Schroeder of Cooley Canal Yacht Club. Rounding out the chairs were Mike Morton of Wyandotte Yacht Club and Kris Miller of Put-in-Bay Yacht Club as vice and rear, respectively. Bob Sheppard of Alum Creek Sailing Association was awarded the Yachtsman of the Year and John Hopper won the Commodore's Award. Steve Harris from Buckeye Lake Yacht Club led the Board of Trustees. There were 147 member clubs in 2011. Sadly, I-LYA lost two past commodores, Norm Winkel (1978) and Rolf Tinge (1993).

The 2011 regattas were all held at Put-in-Bay. Junor Bay (July 17–21) was chaired by a North Cape Yacht Club team of Jeff & Marilyn Mackay and Mark & Karen Keesey. Jack Hunger, John Salisbury, & Repton Salisbury of Cleveland Yachting Club, Mike Gemperline and Emily Schneider of Edgewater Yacht Club, and Stu Fisher of Hoover Sailing Club were the big winners this year. Junior Power was led by Bob Lang, West River Yacht & Cruising Club with Jakob Shoemaker of WRYCC wining the Junior Navigation. Bob Sheppard, ACSA, was Sail chairman. The regatta ran July 27–31. Brian Hartwell's Feisty from Grosse Ile Yacht Club snagged the PHRF Boat of the Year. 2011 Vice Commodore Mike Morton ran the Power Regatta over August 1–7. Bill Stewart of St. Clair Yacht Club won the Commodore's Trophy.

Junior Power Contests

These Junior Regatta contests are designed to reinforce the safe boating practices and rules of the road learned in the classroom. The contests and seminars use a hands-on approach and provide the juniors with the confidence to operate motorized vessels. The vessels used at the regatta are inflatables donated by senior participants of the power regatta. For additional information about the Junior Power Program please visit the I-LYA web-site.

General Knowledge and Seamanship

Friday's safe boating seminar provides each junior with a refresher course on safety requirements, rules of the road, understanding of buoys and their identifying characteristics, hand held GPS and electronic chart instruction, and much more. Juniors will be asked to demonstrate knot tying, line throwing, and how to properly secure a vessel. A written exam, testing each junior on his or her general knowledge of the above concludes this contest.

Charting and Course Plotting

The safe boating seminar also covers charting and course plotting. Hands-on activities teach the juniors how to read charts, determine their position and plot a course. At the end of the seminar, each junior will be tested on their understanding of the above.

Navigation Competition

This is a shore-based contest that will require juniors to pair up and take a short walk or bike ride around the Island. They will be asked to take bearings, make observations and determine their position using hand held GPS as they make their way around the Island. Bikes will be provided if necessary.

Weather Contest

Each junior will be asked to forecast the weather for a prescribed time and place. The forecast will include temperature, wind direction and velocity, barometric pressure, sky conditions, precipitation, and relative humidity. Prediction forms will be provided and must be submitted by a set deadline. A committee shall assemble at the prescribed place and time to observe and record the actual weather conditions and determine the winners of this contest.



"COURSE A" Boat Handling Contest "Course A" will demonstrate the steering and boat handling capabilities of each junior. The junior, accompanied by an assigned adult, will run a 3-leg course in both a clockwise and counter-clockwise direction with the objective of making both runs in the same amount of time. Speed is NOT the objective.

"COURSE B" Compass Reading and Bearings Contest "Course B" will demonstrate a junior's ability to read a compass and take bearings and identify your position using hand held GPS. The goal is to steer as carefully as possible between the marks for each of three designated courses set by the committee. At the end of each leg the junior is to record the compass heading steered. An assigned adult will crew on each vessel.





Chicane This is a timed test of boat handling and low speed maneuvering. The junior will be timed and judged on his or her ability to successfully maneuver through a prescribed course at no-wake speed in 2 directions without creating a wake and without hitting the marks on the course.

Docking This contest evaluates the junior's boat handling and maneuvering skills as related to docking. The junior will be judged on his/her ability to properly maneuver, dock and secure his or her vessel within a predetermined dock space. Hitting the dock and/or high speed operations will result in loss of points.

Social Competitions

In addtion to the bragging rights earned by making a hole-in-one during Jr. Putt-Putt or Jr. East trouncing Jr. West (or vice-versa) in volleyball, Junior Power Regatta participants also enjoy the following contests:

Geo-Quest

Based on Geo-caching, Geo-Quest is a live treasure hunt utilizing compass and GPS skills. Junior teams will explore the island via adult-driven golf carts and locate hidden "treasures."

Fishing Derby

The "Fishing Derby" is designed for all juniors participating in the regatta. Come one, come all and see who catches the largest, the most and the smallest fish. The committee will be available to bait your hooks and will supply the bait as well as snacks for the anglers. Bring your pole and your life jacket and arrive 15 minutes before start time so you will be ready to drop your hook. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the finish time. So don't be late and good luck!

Awards

Ribbons: are given to each winner of the four On-the-Water contests, the Weather contest, and the land/shore based Navigation competition. 1st, 2^d or 3^d place ribbon awards are provided depending upon participation.

Junior Skipper Award and Trophy: is given to the individual having the highest total combined score for all On-the-Water contests and the Weather contest.

Scholarships: 1st, 2d & 3d place monetary scholarship awards are given to the eligible juniors with the highest overall score for all competitions.

- 1. Only those juniors who are members of a boat club affiliated with I-LYA will be eligible to receive scholarship awards.
- 2. Scholarships are based on final results from 2 days of competitions at the annual I-LYA Regatta.



Power Contests

Commodore's Trophy

Competition for the Commodore's Trophy is based upon a combination of seamanship, boat handling and overall knowledge of boating. Four events have been selected by the committee which provide all of these skills. To compete you must enter all four (4) contests. Entry forms are available at the Registrars desk and must be completed and on file to compete. A percentage has been given to each event to determine the overall winner of the Commodore's Trophy. A flag and pin will be presented to the winner and the winner's name will be placed on the Commodore's Trophy which is awarded at the I-LYA Fall Banquet each year. This trophy is an individual award and will be awarded to an *individual* competing in the various events NOT to a competing team. Commodore's Trophy contests include: Predicted Log & Navigation (30%), Docking (25%), Chicane (25%) and Weather Forecasting (20%).

Predicted Log

The Predicted Log is a boat handling contest. A contestant's knowledge of their boat's performance and good navigation skills are necessary. A predetermined course is designed around a set of control points; which include buoys, markers, and landmarks, which must be passed on the port or starboard side of the boat, as designated. A contestant's calculation of his/her predicted log requires the contestant to plot the designated course on his/her own chart and predict the elapsed time, in minutes and seconds, that he/she will pass each control point. Contestants must run the course at their chosen speed, higher than six knots; their prediction should be based on their chosen speed. The use of GPS is allowed when running the course. However the use of auto-pilot during the contest is strictly prohibited. Contestants should know their boat's compass deviation, as most control points are not visible from the start of a leg. The Predicted Log committee will assign an impartial observer to accompany the contestant during the run. Each contestant is asked to bring at least one observer, who will be assigned to another contestant's boat. A short training class will be held for observers before the start of the contest. Each contestant must furnish two watches able to read in hours, minutes and seconds.

Start Buoy R "2" FI R 4s, PIB Harbor Entrance Leave to Port Steer a course at 250 degrees T for 2.60 NM (2.99 SM). At that point, give timepiece to the observer and proceed to:

Control Pt. 1Buoy G "1" FI G 4s, Scott Point ShoalLeave to PortControl Pt. 2Buoy Y Can "D," Erie Proving GroundsLeave to PortFinishBuoy R "2" FI R 4s, PIB Harbor EntranceLeave to Starboard

Committee Distance 21.31 NM

Specific instructions will be provided in the contest packet. Each contestant must complete the entry form provided by the committee. This contest is not intended to be a team event. However, if a team wishes to compete, and if eligible, only one flag will awarded to the team captain. Only the team captain will be eligible to compete for the Commodore's Trophy.

Docking

This is a contest of boat handling and the ability to maneuver your vessel dockside. This contest is not a contest of speed. However, your time is recorded and used for determination of final finish placement and tie breaking decisions. When your vessel is called to compete, maneuver your vessel dockside and set your dock lines. The committee will set marks forward and aft of your vessel. These marks are used to define the space you have to maneuver your vessel. The committee will give you the signal to start and you will leave the dock, go to harbor and make a complete 360 degree turn. Once your turn is complete you will return to the dock and maneuver your vessel to dockside within the marks previously set.

Chicane

The object of the Chicane is to maneuver through the course with your engines in forward gear. Upon completion of the marked course make a 360 degree turn with your vessel. After completing the 360 degree turn, you must maneuver your vessel with engines in reverse back through the course returning to the start/finish line. You will be timed for the entire time it takes to run the complete course (both forward and reverse runs). You will be penalized for hitting a mark or making a wake.

Weather Forecasting

The contest form shall be filled in completely and filed with the Weather Forecast Committee by the time and day posted on the entry form and in the Regatta schedule. Twenty-two (22) hours later, at 1500 hours (3:00 PM) or as otherwise noted on the entry form, a committee appointed for the purpose shall assemble at Put-in-Bay to observe and record the actual weather conditions at the time and place described on the entry form. These conditions shall then be compared to the contestants' predictions and penalty points assessed for all variations. The winner shall be the contestant receiving the least number of penalty points.

Flying Mile

All boats will be timed electronically using a radar gun. Boats will NOT be required to run a full mile at their top speed. All boats will be timed within a 500 foot area designated by the committee. Two (2) or more participants are required to establish a class. No boat will be permitted to run in more than one class. Safety is our number one rule. Please operate your vessel in a safe manner. Remember, you are responsible for the safety of your vessel and all others on board.

Social Competitions

Social competitions include the East vs. West Volleyball, the co-ed Softball Game, and senior Corn Hole. Volleyball takes place on the PIBYC grounds and the softball game, at the school. Because most of the participants play these games only once a year, the spectators usually get a good laugh from the weekend warriors but occasionally see some impressive athleticism. The rivalry is sometimes intense but always good-natured. A trophy is naturally awarded to the victors but bragging rights are the real "Gold Medal" that is sought.

General Information

- The SAFETY of all participants, crew, committee and audience is our number one rule. While participating in these contests, we ask all to observe navigation rules of the road, local laws and follow all safe boating practices. Please conduct yourself in an orderly and professional manner at all times and not put fellow participants, general public or the committee at risk or cause unnecessary nuisance. We want everyone to enjoy these contests whether on land or sea, please remember to BE SAFE.
- 2. These Contests and their rules have been prepared by the various contest committees and approved by the Powerboat Committee. From time to time, weather and scheduling conflicts may require changes or modifications to the schedule or contest rules. The various Committee chairpersons will make every effort to inform you of any last minute changes.
- The success of the Regatta is directly related to participation in these contests and events. There is a first, second and third place flag given to the Clubs with the most participants in Regatta contests and events.
- 4. In addition to the Club Participation award, Clubs are eligible to receive an award for volunteerism. This is awarded to the Club having the most volunteers working the various contests, events and social functions. If you are a committee chairperson, it is very important to record the hours worked by your many volunteers in order that clubs are credited with all the hours earned during the Regatta.
- 5. Protests of judges' ruling can be filed with the Powerboat Committee. The Powerboat Committee will review the protest and make a final ruling.
- Electronic copy of the official Regatta "Contest Rules Booklet" is available from the I-LYA website (<u>i-lya.org</u>). Also, hard copies are available at the Registrar's desk.


